## ADDENDUM NO. 3

The following are clarification and additions to the construction documents to be included with bid:

- Item No. 3.1 Drawing A-1: There are notes on the drawings that refer to the "owner" removing the following. (Interior desk, soffit, abandoned plumbing, and 1 section of bookcases. Is this correct?)
- Response For Bid Alternate 01 The Contractor shall be responsible for the removal of the spiral stairwell, the soffit, and the Chilled Water Piping concealed in the soffit. These items become the property and responsibility of the contractor to dispose of in an environmentally acceptable fashion.
- Item No. 3.2 Note on Cover Sheet regarding "Additional cooling, 24/7, shall be required for the server rooms." Also, there is a note in the phasing plans referring to providing temporary cooling in the computer rooms. Are these rooms the same as the server rooms? We are to install a new split A/C System that cools 2 server rooms. Are there additional server rooms not shown that require temporary cooling? If so, where are they located and how much temporary cooling is required for the server rooms and computer rooms?
- Response

  For Bid Alternate 01 There is currently County owned temporary spot coolers cooling the IT Rooms on the first floor. These units are to be replaced with AH 1-1 and AH 1-2 indicated on Sheet M-0.1. The air handlers are to be located in the same location as these temporary spot coolers. The contractor shall make provisions to have continuous cooling available to these IT Rooms, through the completion of the project. The Contractor may use the temporary spot coolers to provide this cooling, as long heat is expelled from the space. Temporary spot coolers shall be cleaned and turned over to County upon removal from space.
- Item No. 3.3 Drawing M-1: A new valve box is shown with connections for a temporary chiller. Are these connections for the temporary cooling noted above or for future use in case of loss of chilled water from the Judicial Center?
- **Response**The valve box indicated on Sheet M-1 is provided for Chilled Water service to the Historic Courthouse in the event of loss of the Judicial Center Chiller Plant, and is not for temporary cooling during the construction period.
- Item No. 3.4 The Construction Documents shall be modified to include the following information to Specification 011000 Summary: Section 1.9 Work Restrictions (page 011000-5). The Contractor shall provide a minimum 5 working day notice to the Owner for weekend work, such that the Owner can coordinate Security Guard for the facility.
