**BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION**

Manatee County Procurement Division has completed a due diligence review and intends to procure Flowserve pumps service, installation, parts and equipment from A.C. Schultes of Florida, Inc without conducting a competitive solicitation process for the following reason(s):

The Utilities Department has the need for pumps for the water treatment processes. The County has established a standard use of the Flowserve OEM line of pumps for certain processes. A.C. Schultes of Florida, Inc. is the sole and exclusive representative for Flowserve pumps. Flowserve pumps are already in use at the water treatment facilities throughout the county in various areas and continued use will allow maximum efficiency and reduced downtime with uniformed pumps throughout Manatee County.
