- Q1. Please provide the Engineer's Estimate for this project.
- R1. The Engineer's Estimate for this project is \$1.5 million.

- Q2. During the pre-bid, it was discussed that existing equipment removed would be turned over to the county and the county would provide a dumpster for waste material. Please confirm that this is correct.
- R2. All existing devices and equipment that is removed shall be turned over to the county for disposition. Contractor is responsible for removal of general waste such as discarded packaging, demo debris, etc. The county shall not provide a dumpster for waste materials.
- Q3. Taxes are only mentioned in the Change Order documents which were made a part of the original bid solicitation. It was stated at the pre-bid that bidders are to include and are responsible for paying sales tax on installed materials. Please confirm this is correct.
- R3. Bidders, please reference Article A.24 Taxes, on page A-10 and A-11 of the Invitation for Bid.
- Q4. Specification Section 27 00 00, General Technology Requirements, Section 3.22 Testing and Acceptance, paragraph (G), refers to cable integrity. Defective cable to be replaced at contractor's expense. Does this apply to existing cable? This was discussed during the pre-bid and it was stated that this statement does not apply to existing wire and cable. Please confirm this is correct.
- R4. This is correct. Any defective cable should be brought to the attention of the Owner. Owner shall then determine whether the cable will be repaired / replaced and by whom. Should the Owner determine to have the contractor repair / replace the defective cable, appropriate Change Order procedures will be followed.
- Q5. Please verify that the expected project duration is 330 calendar days as stated at the pre-bid meeting.
- R5. Yes, this project is based on a 330 calendar day completion time as stated on the bid form.
- Q6. It was discussed at the pre-bid that to be a prime bidder, a Certified or Registered Florida Electrical Contractor's License is required. Please confirm if this is the case.

## **R6.** Revised Qualifications

The prime contractor shall be a <u>Certified or Registered Florida Electrical Contractor OR a Certified Alarm System Contractor I OR a Certified Specialty Contractor OR a Certified Alarm System Contractor II pursuant to Florida Statute 489 and who has continuously held the certification or registration for a period of at least five (5) consecutive years immediately prior to the day the bid is submitted, may be qualified to bid on this Work.</u>

Contractor shall have a minimum of five (5) years' experience and performed at least six (6) similar projects exceeding \$500,000.00. A similar project would be defined as a project where the PLC and intercom systems were replaced and the Scope of Work exceed \$500,000.00. Projects that required video surveillance systems to be replaced are acceptable, as long as the intercom Scope of Work exceeded \$500,000.00.

- Q7. It was discussed at the pre-bid that the Grounding Cable throughout the building does not have to be routed in conduit. Please confirm this is the case.
- R7. All insulated conductors, power and grounding for this effort shall be concealed to the greatest extend possible. The concealed conductors shall be securely supported to the structure in accordance with the NEC. Where the conductor route must be exposed, the conductor (s) shall be installed in Electrical Metallic Tubing (EMT). All exposed conduit routes shall be approved prior to installation. The Electrical Rooms may allow exposed conductor routes, provided that they do not interfere with equipment or allow damage to the conductor. Ground conductor may be run with signal and controls cable if only a single conduit is available. Contractor shall provide code compliant fire stop at all rated fire and smoke walls.
- Q8. Please confirm that the new system, both PLC's and Touch Screen stations, will be connected to the Owner's network. This includes a Cat 6 cable to each Touch Screen and PLC location with exception of in the Annex, whereby the contractor is to furnish and install a Cat 6 cable, in an existing conduit, removing old cable from the direct supervision counter in the dayroom to the center Pod Control (total of 4 locations).
- R8. Touch Screens will not be utilized with the new equipment. All HMI's will have standard monitors to be mouse driven. The Owner will install cable as required to all required locations with the exception of the 4 Annex pods as described. The Owner will assign VLANS based on the contractor's recommendations. The contractor should also request static IP addresses in a detailed list by system.
- Q9. Please confirm that the scope of work includes the replacement of all 24 VDC Lock Power Supplies as well as existing door relay boards.
- R9. Yes, all power supplies shall be replaced with new relay boards including all door relay boards.
- Q10. It was discussed at the pre-bid that the existing cabinets may be re-used by the successful contractor and new equipment installed within. Please confirm this is the case.

- R10. Yes, the cabinets may be reused at the contractor's discretion. Rack extenders may be required at a few select locations to accommodate the depth of the intercom equipment. These are ok so long as they do not impede on the 3' of clearance required in front of certain electrical equipment.
- Q11. Provide location of the Main Earth Ground for connection of the new grounding system.
- R11. The Main Earth Ground is located in the main Electrical Room and may be tapped from "SES1 - Section 1" Grounding buss or enhance existing building steel grounding lugs in the ceiling space to terminate the new conductor.
- Q12. Are the ceiling locations in the Annex accessible for the routing of the new grounding cable? During the pre-bid walk-through, this did not appear to be the case. If there are areas where ceilings are not accessible, what methods will be required for the routing of grounding cable?
- R12. Annex Building "A", hard ceiling locations do have some hatches to gain access and may prove challenging, however new hatches may be added with approval. Surface mounted conduit may be routed exposed, with approval. An alternate route to the exterior of the building between the Electrical Room and control room, in conduit, may also be added with approval.

In Annex Building "B", the conduit for grounding may be routed between the local Electrical Room, through the room above and into the drop ceiling, then down to the control booth at first floor level, then also routed in existing under-slab conduits between the Control Room and control board consoles in the four dormitories.
