EVALUATION RESULTS SUMMARY:

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The Evaluation Committee first convened on March 27, 2018 and conducted technical evaluations of the four (4) responsible, responsive, proposals received. . The Evaluation Committee met on March 27, 2018 for final technical evaluations and unanimously voted to recommend award to 1) Precision Contracting Services, Jupiter, FL and 2) Harris-McBurney.

TECHNICAL EVALUATIONS

The Evaluation Committee (the "Committee") initially convened to review and engage in discussion of the proposals.
