- R1. Proposer must confirm that you are ADA compliant and/or have a program in place.
- Q2. Is there an anticipated total fee for the contract.
- R2. The estimated budget is approximately \$200,000.00.
- Q3. Can we show Manatee County staff and projects as part of our five references and related projects?
- R3. Yes.
- Q4. Could you please provide clarification on how long the firm has to provide County written comments? Tab 7, Item 3 (p. 54) states: 3. Approach to provide the County written comments within 10 business days of receipt of the traffic Impact Analysis or responses to comments; and Scope, 1.06 Schedule, Section A (p. 47): The Consultant will complete all tasks in accordance with Manatee County review schedules and the HB 7103. The initial TIA submittal will be completed within twenty working days following receipt of the documents

for review. The sufficiency reviews will be completed within twenty working days following receipt of the revised submittal. It is anticipated that all provisions of the scope can be completed within six months of Notice to Proceed.

R4. County staff needs time to process responses to comments provided. This difference of time (10 days) provides flexibility based on complexity of traffic studies and allows staff and selected consultant to discuss and clarify any item. The County will be responsible to provide final comments to the applicant.
