QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES:

Q1. Are we permitted to use 11x17 pages?

R1. The use of 11 x 17 pages is permissible only when responding to item 3 in Tab 7, for your firm's proposed schedule.

Q2. On October 1, 2019 HB827/SB616 went into effect creating the rules for Administrative code 61G15, which removes the requirement that engineers obtain a separate engineering business license (certificate of authorization) for their engineering firm. Considering this, for Tab 2 Item 2, are we to provide only individual staff licenses of our team members?

R2. For Tab 2, item 2, proposers are to provide the information of the qualifying agent in accordance with the applicable Florida Statute sections 471.023, 481.219, or 481.319.

No additional questions will be considered after the issuance of this Addendum No. 1.
