Proposers are hereby notified that this <u>Addendum shall be acknowledged within their proposal</u> and shall be made a part of the above named Request for Proposal documents as if contained within the original.

The following items are issued to add to, modify, and clarify the Request for Proposals (RFP) documents. These items shall have the same force and effect as the original RFP documents. Proposals are to be submitted on the specified date, on or before the specified time and shall conform to the additions and revisions listed herein.

1. Question: Section C.03 is missing a tab, C.03.7. Is there a requirement for this tab or is it numbered incorrectly?

Answer: There is no requirement for C.03.7, it was numbered incorrectly.

2. <u>Question</u>: In reference to item C.03.8, as we prepare our quotation, are there to be any trades to consider?

Answer: Manatee County has 28 Philips Monitor / Defibrillators to trade in.

3. <u>Question</u>: Our Code-Stat data review software is sold by the license (or seat), do you know how many licenses would be needed?

<u>Answer</u>: Please indicate the number of licenses included with the software. If it is not unlimited, then include the cost for each license above the amount of licenses indicated in the pricing.

4. Question: We suggest (4) batteries per device. The RFP indicates that the total is TBD. Should we list (4) batteries per device or leave it at just (1) battery and you can complete the math based on the final quantity that is determined?

<u>Answer</u>: Include the suggestion of (4) batteries per device but include the per battery price and Public Safety will make the final determination.

All other terms and conditions of Request for Proposal 16-0775CP remain unchanged.

Proposals will be received until January 29, 2016 at 4:00 P.M. in the Purchasing Division Conference Room, 1112 Manatee Avenue West, Suite 803, Bradenton, FL 34205.
