The Manatee County Procurement Division provides notice of its intent to award a sole source contract with a value of \$99,360.00 with Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc. for the provision of ArcGIS Online Premium Feature Data Store M-4 Annual Subscription.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

Manatee County Procurement Division has completed a due diligence review and intends to procure ArcGIS Online Premium Feature Data Store M-4 Annual Subscription from Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc. without conducting a competitive solicitation process for the following reason(s).

Manatee County officially entered into an Enterprise License Agreement with Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc. (ESRI) on October 9, 2018. This strategic agreement successfully enrolled the County into the esteemed Enterprise Advantage Program, granting access to an array of specialized training options and professional services. Particularly notable is the provision of the standard tier data store, which bolsters the County's ArcGIS Online corporate environment. During the tumultuous seasons of Hurricanes Helene and Milton, Manatee County heavily relied on ESRI software, pushing the standard data store capabilities to the limit. This highlighted the critical need for an upgrade to prevent similar challenges in future crises. Enhancing the County's ESRI database capability is vital to ensuring preparedness for large-scale natural disasters. It's imperative to acknowledge that ESRI stands as the esteemed owner, manufacturer, and exclusive provider of their software solutions, including the versatile ArcGIS variants.
