**Bid price** Task 1: (540' boardwalk): Making such preparations as are necessary including removing large stainless carriage bolts and rails to remove deck boards. Remove 3"x6" deck boards and flip 180 degrees to ensure less weathered surface is facing upwards while minimizing damage to railing structure. Boards should be re-fastened with minimum 4" #12 stainless steel Alloy 304, A2 wood screws using the same number as are removed and sunk to be beneath the walking surface of the wood. Also, replacement of 3"x8"x8' cross spars(x50) that brace boardwalk pilings including reinstallation of piling segment spacer while re-using stainless bolts. Task 2: (150' bridge): Making such preparations as are necessary including removing large stainless carriage bolts and rails to remove deck boards. Remove 3"x6" deck boards and flip 180 degrees to ensure less weathered surface is facing upwards while minimizing damage to railing structure. Boards should be re-fastened with minimum 4" #12 stainless steel Alloy 304, A2 wood screws using the same number as are removed and sunk to be beneath the walking surface of the wood.

#### SCHEDULE OF VALUES

## PART 1 GENERAL

## 1.01 REQUIREMENTS INCLUDED

- A. The Contractor shall submit to the County a Schedule of Values allocated to the various portions of the work, within 10 days after date of Notice to Proceed.
- B. Upon request of the County, the Contractor shall support the values with data which will substantiate their correctness.
- C. The Schedule of Values shall be used only as the basis for the Contractor's Applications for Payment.

## 1.02 FORM AND CONTENT OF SCHEDULE OF VALUES

- A. Schedule of Values will be considered for approval by County upon Contractor's request. Identify schedule with:
  - 1. Title of Project and location.
  - 2. Project number.
  - 3. Name and address of Contractor.
  - 4. Contract designation.
  - Date of submission.
- B. Schedule of Values shall list the installed value of the component parts of the work in sufficient detail to serve as a basis for computing values for progress payments during construction.
- C. Follow the table of contents for the Contract Document as the format for listing component items for structures:
  - 1. Identify each line item with the number and title of the respective major section of the specification.
  - 2. For each line item, list sub values of major products or operations under item.
- D. Follow the bid sheets included in this Contract Documents as the format for listing component items for pipe lines.
- E. The sum of all values listed in the schedule shall equal the total Contract sum.







