### NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD

The Manatee County Procurement Division provides notice of its intent to award a contract with Carlson Environmental Consultants, PC for the provision of Stage II, Phase I GCCS Expansion – Lena Road Landfill.

### BACKGROUND/EVALUATION

The Scope of Work includes the following: construction staking, system layout, and surveying; installation of landfill gas extraction wells, laterals, header pipes, dewatering discharge lines, air supply lines, isolation valves, valve vaults, tie-ins, gas wellheads, and pneumatic pumps; grading, seeding, sodding, and restoring site conditions; conformance surveying; and providing as-built documentation.

The solicitation was advertised on December 19, 2019 through the Manatee County website, DemandStar, Tempo News, and the Bradenton Herald newspaper. It was also provided to the Manatee County Chamber of Commerce and Manasota Black Chamber of Commerce for release to their members. A response was received from the following firm:
