## **BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION**

Manatee County Procurement Division has completed a due diligence review and intends to procure septic tank and drain field replacement from Tampa Bay Septic Inc. without conducting a competitive solicitation process for the following reason(s):

There has been a challenge trying to get quotes from more than two vendors. While trying to get this resolved, the lack of drainage in the septic's drain field at the Q-house is causing the County to pay for pumping services multiple times per year, which will not be necessary once this service has been completed. More importantly to the staff and guests, it leads to overflowing in the front yard during heavy rains, creating an unpleasant odor that affects the area for days even after the rain has stopped. Tampa Bay Septic Inc.'s prompt attention will help alleviate this issue.
