- Approval to enter into negotiations with the selected firms, multiply firms are selected to meet the County's elderly citizen's needs.
- Manatee County has the need to acquire CCE Homemaker Services as outlined in the RFP. The RFP requires firms to
 provide homemaker services to establish a clean, safe living environment to a functionally impaired elderly person.
- 1/27/10 4/30/10 the appropriate proposal procedures were followed. The Request for Proposal (RFP) was broadcast via DemandStar to twenty nine (29) CCE Homemaker Services firms; ten (10) firms downloaded the RFP and six (6) firms' submitted proposals.
- The RFP was advertized locally in the Bradenton Herald, posted on the County's website and provided to the Manatee County Chamber of Commerce for release to members.
- The Selection Committee consisted of:

• The Selection Committee convened 4/23/10 and shortlisted the following firms:

All Stat Home Health, Sarasota, FL Approved Home Health Care, Bradenton, FL Home Instead Senior Care, Bradenton, FL Utopia Home Care, Inc., St. Petersburg, FL

- The Selection Committee convened 4/30/10 to hear oral presentations from the shortlisted firms and then ranked the
 firms as follows: It was determined that all four (4) shortlisted firms would be awarded contracts in various dollar
 amounts based on the Committee perceived view of their ability to perform.
- Ranked #1, Approved Home Health Care, Bradenton, FL The proposer was determined to best meet the needs of the County for CCE homemaker service and has been successfully performing these services for County. Of particular importance are the firms past experience; organizational structure; and a willingness to work with the County. Estimated percentage of work to be performed 39%.
- Ranked #2, Home Instead Senior Care, Bradenton, FL The firm submitted a professional proposal demonstrating their ability to provide the required services and has satisfactorily provided these services to the County in the past. However, was not ranked as highly as the top ranked firm by the Selection Committee. Estimated percentage of work to be performed 29%.
- Ranked #3, Utopia Home Care, Inc., St. Petersburg, FL Its proposal responses addressed all categories requested in
 the RFP and detailed their years of experience in providing CCE homemaker services. While service issues were
 initially encountered with this firm corrective actions have been implemented and the firm is performing satisfactorily.
 Estimated percentage of work to be performed 17%.

- Ranked #4, All Stat Home Health, Sarasota, FL The firm submitted a satisfactory proposal and made an informative
 oral presentation with many interesting ideas for the CCE homemaker industry. However the firm was ranked fourth
 overall due their lack of experience with Manatee County Government. Estimated percentage of work to be performed
 15%.
- The remaining proposal respondents were not ranked, although well qualified they were not selected based on a comparison of capabilities of the selected firm.
