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RFQ 16-3010GE: Traffic Intersection Relamping ADDENDUM 1

The following addendum is issued to add to, modify, and/or clarify the above named solicitation documents. The items contained within this Addendum shall have the same force and effect as if contained within the first issued solicitation document and any cost involved shall be factored into the response. Quoters shall acknowledge receipt of this and any other addenda issued pursuant to this Request for Quotes (RFQ) in their quote submittal.

Question 1 - Is there an established material procurement period, and a specific number of "days to complete", from issuance of purchase order or contract?

Response 1 – From receipt of Purchase Order we require 8 weeks for product/material procurement and 90 days for installation.

Question 2 - If "Jones Plugs" are encountered, are they to be replaced with new ones, or wire new signal heads directly to terminal strip in disconnect?

Response 2 - We do not use Jones plugs. If one is found it may be bypassed or removed completely.

Question 3 - One of the mast arm intersections specified, currently utilizes a much older "banded" type astro bracket . Although these brackets may not be damaged/broken, does the county have interest in changing these out, to an updated "cable" type?

Response 3 - We don't want to do any "upgrades" but if it is broken or not serviceable then it should be replaced/ upgraded. Some of these older brackets may have rusted hardware or may break as a result of being serviced due to age, so if that occurs as an unforeseen repair/replacement, a change order will be issued under a "case-by-case" basis to be preapproved by the County.

Question 4 - On the "Contractors Questionnaire" the "Current Florida Business Registration #". Are you referencing the Florida Dept. of State document #, confirming a current Florida Corporation?

Response 4 – Yes, per the "Qualifications of the Contractor", contractors must be registered to do business in Florida. The registration number satisfies that requirement.
