- On November 7, 2006, the Board of County Commissioners approved the agreement between
 The City of Bradenton and Manatee County Government for the lease and capital
 improvements to Norma Lloyd Park. The agreement states that the County will lease Norma
 Lloyd Park from The City of Bradenton for a period of fifty (50) years commencing November 7,
 2006. The agreement states that the County will perform overall management responsibilities
 for the Park, including capital improvements which will be funded by The City of Bradenton,
 CCRA and various grants, and constructed by the County.
- This project provides for the following improvements to Norma Lloyd Park, Phase 1.
 Excavation of a retention pond, grading, installation of drainage piping, all piping tie-in, the removal of asphalt in the sports field area, removal of trees, installation of a irrigation-rotor system for the sports field, including booster pump, backflow and meter, sodding the outside of the sports field and planting tifway 419 plugs for the soccer fields.

- 10/14/2008 through 11/10/2008 Appropriate bid procedures were followed. Bid was posted on
 the Manatee County Web Site and notice directly delivered via Onvia DemandStar to two
 thousand one hundred fifty-four (2154) prospective bidders including twenty-four (24) Manatee
 County firms listed above. One hundred forty-five (145) firms requested Bid Documents,
 including the twenty-four (24) Manatee County firms. Eight (8) bids were received. Of the
 eight (8) bids received, three (3) bids were from Manatee County firms and five (5) from the
 surrounding area.
- The apparent low bidder, Gator Grading and Paving, LLC, Bradenton, FL exceeded the maximum of 45% threshold for the amount of subcontracted work as detailed in Section D.07 of the Invitation for Bid Requirements.

<u>Section D.07</u>, <u>Subcontractors</u>, <u>Suppliers and Other</u> states "No more than 45% of the Total Bid Price, including labor and materials shall be performed by subcontractors".

Superior Asphalt, Inc., Oneco, FL is the lowest responsive, responsible Bidder meeting all Terms and Conditions of the Information for Bid.
