**BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION**

Manatee County Procurement Division has completed a due diligence review and intends to procure Landfill Gas Blower and Control System For Biosolid Dryer Facility from Flare Services LLC without conducting a competitive solicitation process for the following reason(s):

Flare Services LLC originally designed and installed the current burner system along with all associated programming. Proprietary issues are involved with the burner program and switching to another programming engineer would require extensive programming/re-programming work at a significant cost.

Based upon these and other factors, the County plans to standardize the above referenced product.
