**NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD A SINGLE SOURCE CONTRACT**

The Manatee County Procurement Division provides notice of its intent to award a single source contract with a value of \$53,683.58 with Getinge USA Sales, LLC for the provision of a three-year IC Getinge Care Premium Service preventive maintenance plan for the County’s Central Laboratory’s steam sterilizers and integrated boilers for the period January 1, 2021, through December 31, 2023. This purchase requisition is for year two of a three-year contract for a total two-year encumbrance of \$34,909.24.

**BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION**

Manatee County Procurement Division has completed a due diligence review and intends to procure year two renewal of a three-year agreement for IC Getinge Care Premium Service Plan from Getinge USA Sales, LLC without conducting a competitive solicitation process for the following reason(s):

Getinge USA Sales’ stabilizers and boilers are used for microbiological testing to ensure FDEP and FDOH compliance. Getinge USA Sales has the tools and equipment that are specific to the Central Lab’s machinery. They are the sole source for preventive maintenance for their stabilizers and boilers.
