BACKGROUND/EVALUATION

At the request of the Utilities Department, the Procurement Division solicited Request for Qualifications (RFQ) No. 23-R081162BB for as-needed Subsurface Utility Engineering (SUE) services.

EVALUATION SUMMARY:

The Evaluation Committee first convened on May 2, 2023 to conduct technical evaluations of the responsible, responsive proposals received, which resulted in a unanimous vote to shortlist the seven top-ranked firms. On May 9, 2023, the Procurement Division conducted discussions with the seven shortlisted firms in the form of submitting Requests for Information via email to the seven firms. On May 12, 2023, the Procurement Division provided the Evaluation Committee with each firm's responses to the Requests for Information. On May 16, 2023, the Evaluation Committee reconvened for technical evaluations of the shortlisted firms, which resulted in a unanimous vote to enter into negotiations with the two top-ranked firms: DRMP, Inc. and George F. Young, Inc.
