SOLICITATIONS:  The RFP was advertised on the Manatee County website, DemandStar, and was also provided to the Manatee County Chamber of Commerce for release to its members. #### **EVALUATION RESULTS:**

The Evaluation Committee Meeting #1 convened on May 28, 2015 1:30 P.M. – 3:00 P.M. to discuss procedures and responsibilities of Evaluation Committee members and developed a shortlist for oral presentations.

Oral presentations were made to the Evaluation Committee on June 25 and 26, 2015 from 9:00 A.M. to 12:00 P.M. by the shortlisted firms.

The final Evaluation Committee Meeting was convened on June 26, 2015 11:30 A.M. to discuss the offers based on the RFP's requirements and the oral presentations, continuing the acquisition process with the Committee's recommendation to the County Administrator. The Committee selected three (3) of the four (4) shortlisted firms to be used on an as needed basis, and those firms are listed in alphabetical order with the Departments selecting the firm via work assignments to provide the necessary consulting services.

**KimleyHorn, Sarasota, FL** – KimleyHorn demonstrated exceptional qualification via their proposal and oral presentation. Additionally, the firm provides: a complete set of in house services that both Departments could take advantage of; community experience on various local projects; offers planning and redevelopment services; and public participation tailored to local project and understands the need for implementation after the writing of planning and develop codes.

**Littlejohn Engineering Associates, Inc., Orlando, FL** – Littlejohn's presentation supported their vast experiences and expertise as described in their proposal. Highlights of the evaluation committee comments include: understanding of the County's process; current performance for the County has provided good result; offers the necessary multi-disciplines for public sector organizations; code writing abilities are excellent and has no land use project conflicts,

**Tindale Oliver, Tampa, FL** – The firm's proposal and presentation were both well received by the Evaluation Committee. Of particular importance was: vast experience throughout the State of Florida with a nice mix of projects; have in house capabilities; host GIS for clients; public interaction when reviewing project; strong management and staff with the public sector expertise; and the ability to address difficult issues in front of governing board's as necessary.

**WadeTrim Inc., Tampa, FL (shortlisted but not selected)** – WadeTrim submitted a good proposal with satisfactory examples of past projects and their current abilities. The Evaluation Committee would have liked to hear from the firms selected subcontractors during the presentation. The Committee felt that WadeTrim was just not comparable to the other three firms selected to provide the necessary services and therefore was not selected.

These remaining respondents, although well qualified, were not selected based on a comparison of capabilities of the selected firm.
