This information is issued to add to, modify, and/or clarify the Request for Quotation documents. These items shall have the same force and effect as the original Request for Quotation. Quotes are to be submitted on the specified date and shall conform to the additions and revisions listed herein.

Ouestion:

Provide further details on the "load time charge".

Answer:

The vendor may charge from the time he <u>arrives</u> at the designated site/location <u>through</u> the duration of the designated dumping assignment for normal, after hour, weekend and holiday services:

- Arrive for load and dump at final destination
- Arrive at lift station unload at designated lift station
- Arrive at lift station unload at Landfill (Lena Road WWTP)

Ouestion:

Provide further details on the "grease trap unloading".

Answer:

The vendor may charge from the time he <u>arrives</u> at a Manatee County Government grease trap location <u>through</u> the duration of the designated dumping

assignment.

Question:

Is there a minimum charge for emergency after hour calls where a cancellation call is issued by the County after the driver/truck leave the yard or arrive at designated site location.

Answer:

A two hour minimum charge may be invoiced for cancelled service calls (normal hours, after normal working hours, weekends, and holidays).

Question:

Please clarify the category titled "Hours" (UofM, annual estimate).

Answer:

This category refers to total estimated annual service hours.
