BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The Manatee County Utilities Department has requested to procure the Rohde & Schwarz USA, Inc PR200 Interference Hunting System to enhance the detection and resolution of RF interference impacting the County's SCADA infrastructure. These interferences present significant risks to the proper functioning of telemetry-based systems that oversee lift stations, potentially causing delays in response to malfunctions and resulting in Sanitary Sewer Overflows (SSOs), posing threats to public health and environmental adherence.
