NOTICE OF INTENT TO NEGOTIATE FOR AWARD

The Manatee County Procurement Division provides notice of its intent to award a single source contract with a value of \$259,821.22 with MSB Services, LLC for the provision of design and construction services of a temporary signal at the intersection of US 301 and Canal Road.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

Manatee County Procurement Division has completed a due diligence review and intends to procure design and construction services of a temporary signal at the intersection of US 301 and Canal Road from MSB Services, LLC without conducting a competitive solicitation process for the following reason(s):

The Public Works Department is requesting a non-competitive procurement for the construction and installation of a temporary signal at the intersection of US 301 and Canal Road to address public safety issues caused by recent development in the immediate area.

This non-competitive procurement will address the safety issues within six months versus an estimated twelve to fourteen months should Public Works have to design, obtain FDOT permitting, and complete a competitive solicitation process.

This contractor was chosen based on their past performance and ability to quickly design and obtain FDOT permitting for the construction of a temporary signal as most recently demonstrated for a developer at the intersection of SR 70 and White Eagle Boulevard
