NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD A SINGLE SOURCE CONTRACT

The Manatee County Procurement Division provides notice of its intent to award a single source contract with a value of \$154,664.81 with Icon Technologies for the provision of Manatee County Master Reuse System control panel replacement.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

Manatee County Procurement Division has completed a due diligence review and intends to procure Manatee County Master Reuse System control panel replacement from Icon Technologies without conducting a competitive solicitation process for the following reason(s):

The pump control cabinet and DFS radio system, integral to the lake pump back system of the Manatee County Master Reuse System, have deteriorated and become unreliable due to age. The failing cabinet support structure risks leaving the control cabinets supported only by pump conduits. This system is crucial for transporting stored water to the distribution pumps. Failure could lead to overflow, environmental damage, and permit violations resulting in fines. Replacing the support structure, control cabinets, and communication systems, along with installing new junction boxes and fiber optic cables to prevent moisture damage and ensure reliability, will help prevent costly repairs and water reuse shortages.
