4. Page TS-20, paragraph 9.3 has been revised as follows to address the color and texture of the polyurea coating:

The polyurea coating to be applied to the primary geotextile tubes shall be textured <u>and</u> "white" or "sand" in color to match the native beach. Such textured polyurea coating shall be similar to that provided by <u>the manufacturer listed below</u>, or approved equal. <u>Information and samples of the polyurea texture and color shall be provided to the Engineer for review and approval prior to application.</u>

The following items represent clarifications, additions, deletions and/or modifications to the contract documents for the referenced geotextile tube construction project. This addendum shall hereafter be part of the Contract Documents for the Manatee County, Anna Maria Island, Longboat Pass Geotextile Tube (IFB # 11-2752-OV). Contract Document items not referenced herein remain unchanged. Receipt of this Addendum shall be acknowledged below and on the Bid Form for IFB # 11-2752-OV.

This addendum consists of:

- Engineer's Estimate of Construction Cost
- Revisions to General Conditions GC-9
- Revisions to Technical Provisions TP-8, TP-20 and TP-23

These items replace original items previously issued or are to be added to the Bidding and Construction Documents, as indicated.

PERTAINING TO THE SPECIFICATIONS

1. Page GC-9, section 1.04, paragraph C, has been revised as follows to allow equipment and/or materials stored within the construction area on the beach at night:

The Contractor shall be fully responsible for the security and safekeeping of all materials, equipment and appurtenances required for construction of the Work. The Contractor shall not store materials, equipment or appurtenances on the job site except for those items which are under the direct supervision of the Contractor's staff and which are necessary to the Work being performed on the specific day in question. The Contractor shall move any stored products under the Contractor's control that interfere with operations of the County or adjacent residents. No equipment or materials will be stored on the beach at night. Equipment and/or materials stored within the construction area on the beach at night shall be cordoned or fenced off. All equipment storage, both on and off the beach, is at the Contractor's own risk.

2. Page TS-8, paragraph 11.0 has been revised as follows to allow work on weekends and holidays:

All Work on site, including site preparation, construction, clean-up, and mobilization or demobilization shall be performed during daylight hours only on any calendar day including Saturday, Sunday and holidays, subject to permit conditions and restrictions

Longboat Pass Commercial Dock/Loading Facility. The dock area on the east side of Anna Maria Island, immediately north of Longboat Pass in the City of Bradenton Beach will not be will be available during the timeframe of this project. If the Contractor intends to use this facility, the Contractor shall request permission from the County and provide the dates and description of intended use so the City of Bradenton Beach can be notified.
