ACTION DESIRED

Authorization for the procurement of services for the installation of Sound Abatement Materials in the Traffic Control Facility, Traffic Management Video Room within the Public Safety Center to Zirkelbach Construction, Palmetto, FL.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

- The Florida Department of Transportation and Manatee County Traffic Engineering Division house their Traffic Control Facility within the Public Safety Center. In order to minimize the noise level in the room and to provide optimum performance of the equipment, a Request for Quotation was issued to local vendors to procure the services of a contractor to provide and install Sound Abatement (noise reduction) Materials in accordance with the plans and specifications provided to the contractors.
- Notice of availability was broadcasted to twelve (12) local suppliers via www.mymanatee.org and the Chamber of Commerce in addition to advertising the project in the Bradenton Herald and TEMPO News.
- An Information Conference along with a Site Inspection was held on February 22, 2012 at the Public Safety Center
- Four (4) Quotations and one (1) No Quote were received on March 13, 2012.
- The Request for Quotation included pricing for the Base Project in addition to Base Project plus Alternate No. 1 or Base Project and Alternate No. 2.

- 3/22/2012 – Memorandum dated March 21, 2012 received from Sage Kamiya, P.E., Traffic Engineering Division Manager recommending award of the Base Bid to the lowest, responsive, responsible quoter, Zirkelbach Construction, Inc., Palmetto, FL for a total cost of \$43,724.36 based on a work completion of 45 days after receipt of materials.

After installation and testing of the Base Abatement materials, a determination will be made as to whether or not the Traffic Engineering Division will move forward with Alternate #1 or Alternate #2.

- Funding Source for this project is: Joint Participation Agreement between the State of Florida Department of Transportation and Manatee County for a not to exceed \$60,000.00 (Sixty Thousand Dollars) for actual costs incurred, excluding Local Government overhead.

Recommend the purchase of services for the Installation of Sound Abatement Materials for the Traffic Management Video Room to Zirkelbach Construction, Palmetto, FL the lowest, responsive, responsible quoter meeting all aspects of the terms, conditions, specifications, including Addendum No. 1.
