#### **EVALUATION RESULTS:**

The Evaluation Committee convened on August 1, 2013 for the distribution of proposals and a review of evaluation committee requirements. Discussions also included member's availability for future meetings and the Sunshine Laws as applicable to public meetings.

The Evaluation Committee convened on August 15, 2013 and determined that all proposers should provide an oral interview. Those firms, in alphabetical order, were:

Aetna, Hartford, CT Benecard PBF, Orlando, FL Magellan Pharmacy Solutions, Avon, CT Meridian Health Plan, Detroit, MI Optum Rx, Plano, TX Procare Rx, Miramar, FL WellDyne Rx, Lakeland, FL

The Evaluation Committee convened on September 4 and 5, 2013 to provide for the Oral Interview from each firm.

The Evaluation Committee convened on September 5, 2013 to discuss the offers based on the stated requirements in the RFP and short listed the following firms for final consideration:

Benecard PBF, Orlando, FL Optum Rx, Plano, TX Procare Rx, Miramar, FL

The Evaluation Committee convened on September 13, 2013 to discuss the offers based on the stated requirements in the RFP, continuing the acquisition process and determining a recommendation to the County Administrator.

Optum Rx, Plano, TX – The firm presented its professional capabilities in a clear and concise manner via their proposal. Of particular importance was the firm's pricing structure which when applied to the last year of EHB's pharmaceutical claims provided the lowest cost to the County and while the Committee discussed some account service issues EHB has recently

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encountered Optum Rx was evaluated higher than the other shortlisted firms. Additionally, Optum proposed a network that would be easier to manage for the County, and create less disruption in these areas; eligibility, pharmacy locations, formulary issues, and clinical history as they have successfully performed these services for Manatee County in the past.

Procare Rx, Miramar, FL – The firm submitted an informative proposal detailing their qualifications and its oral presentation created an informative exchange of ideas as to where the PBM industry may be headed especially in the area of specialty drugs. Other favorable points were the firm owned it own claim system, employs innovative strategies regarding specialty medications, and corporate flexibility. While impressed with the firm's qualifications Procare Rx was evaluated second by the Evaluation Committee.

Benecard PBF, Orlando, FL – Benecard PBF submitted a satisfactory proposal and made a good presentation with their team detailing its knowledge of the PBM industry. Other favorable points were their innovative approach to transparency with specialty and mail order medications, as well as their high volume of public sector clients. While currently successfully providing services for Sarasota County Government and proposed a narrow network that excluded Walgreens and Walmart, the firm was evaluated third.

#### REMAINING RESPONDENTS:

These remaining respondents, although well qualified, were not selected based on a comparison of capabilities of the selected firms.

ESTIMATED COST OF SERVICES: The estimated annual expenditure is \$200,000.
