The Manatee County Procurement Division provides notice of its intent to award a single source contract with a value of \$185,480.00 with Hudson Pump and Equipment for the provision of Replacement for Peabody Floway 20 MKL.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

Manatee County Procurement Division has completed a due diligence review and intends to procure the removal of an old pump and installation of a Xylem/Goulds Water Technology (TTO) Model 20RCHC-3 Pump and fittings from Hudson Pump and Equipment without conducting a competitive solicitation process for the following reason(s):

Tencarva/Hudson Pump is the exclusive representative for Goulds Pumps in this area. The Goulds Pump comes with added features such as shaft stabilizers which reduce wear and add longevity to bearings in both the pump and motor. This pump comes equipped with mechanical seal, also reducing wear and adding longevity to the equipment. These reasons will reduce maintenance and repair costs to the County.
