ACTION DESIRED

Notice of Intent to Award a Non-Competitive/Sole Source procurement for parts and services to rebuild two Aqua Guard® Bar Screens with Parkson Corporation, Ft. Lauderdale, Florida, for a total amount of \$106,549.84.

ENABLING/REGULATING AUTHORITY

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

- The equipment has been in service at the County facility for several years and is in continual use filtering debris during the water treatment process. It is malfunctioning and is not working at its optimal; unattended maintenance would eventually interfere with the overall treatment operations.
- This procurement provides for the reconditioning of the equipment's two bar screens to bring the system up to standard. The work will be performed by Parkson Corporation, the equipment's manufacturer and sole provider of replacement parts for the (Aqua Guard®) bar screens.
- County staff is familiar with the operation of this equipment and stores an inventory of parts for minor repairs. Replacing the
 equipment with another manufacturer would require staff training, new parts inventory, and possible engineering to integrate
 new equipment into the system operations. The continued use of this manufacturer will allow for a standardized equipment
 operations, utilizing staff experience and knowledge of the equipment.

If a vendor believes this item is not a noncompetitive procurement, Manatee County Purchasing Division requires prospective vendors provide information regarding their ability to supply the commodity or contractual services described prior to the date indicated for "date contract shall be awarded".


