NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD A SOLE SOURCE CONTRACT

The Manatee County Procurement Division provides notice of its intent to award a sole source contract with a value of \$335,520.00 with Andritz Separation, Inc. for the provision of two (2) bucket elevator replacements and a screw auger conveyor replacement located at the Lena Road Southeast Biosolids Dryer Facility.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

Manatee County Procurement Division has completed a due diligence review and intends to procure two (2) bucket elevator replacements and a new screw auger conveyor located at the Lena Road Southeast Biosolids Dryer Facility from Andritz Separation, Inc. without conducting a competitive solicitation process for the following reason(s).

The Utilities Department located at the Lena Road Southeast Biosolids Dryer Facility utilizes a screw auger conveyor and bucket elevators. The screw auger conveyor and bucket elevators are currently at the end of their useful life cycles. They are no longer in compliance with the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 652 Combustible Dust Hazzard standards. Andritz Separation, Inc. is the sole manufacturer, and the sole distributor of parts and supplies used at the County's biosolids dryer facility for these units. All manufactured components are based on Andritz Separation, Inc. proprietary drawings. Failure to use OEM equipment could result in a loss of functional efficiency and cause safety issues for County personnel.
