TO: All Interested Bidders

SUBJECT: ADDENDUM #5– IFB #16-1803CB – Pump Repair and Machine Work

Bidders are hereby notified that this Addendum shall be acknowledged on Bid Form Page 23 and made a part of the above named bidding and contract documents. Bids submitted without acknowledgment of the Addendum will be considered incomplete.

The following items are issued to add to, modify, and clarify the bid and contract documents. These items shall have the same force and effect as the original bidding and contract documents, and cost involved shall be included in the bid prices. Bids to be submitted on the specified bid date, shall conform to the additions and revisions listed herein.

Item #1 – Page 7, **CHANGE A.18 Scrutinized Companies** to read as follows:

Florida Statutes § 287.135, as amended from time to time, may contain limitations on the part of a company to conduct business with the County. Submission of a response to this solicitation shall be subject to all procedural requirements contained within that statute including the submission of any required certification of eligibility to contract with the County. It shall be the responsibility of the company responding to this solicitation to concurrently review the current version of the statute and ensure it is compliant. To the extent a certification is required, it shall be provided on the form located as **Attachment F** to this addendum: *Vendor Certification Regarding Scrutinized Companies Lists*.

Item #2 – Question: What is your annual expenditure?

Answer: Estimated annual expenditure is \$406,000.

Item #3 – Page 18, **ADD B.12 Security Protocol**

The successful Contractor(s) shall provide to the County criminal background checks from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE), for all employees that the Contractor(s) intends to use to perform work at County facilities. The cost of the criminal background checks from the FDLE shall be the sole responsibility of the Contractor(s). The successful Contractor(s) employees must have a valid Florida ID at all times when providing services at different County facilities.

The employment of unauthorized aliens by any Contractor/Vendor is considered a violation of Section 274(e) of the Immigration and Employment Act. If the Contractor/Vendor knowingly employs unauthorized aliens, such violation shall be cause for unilateral cancellation of this agreement.

Item #4 – Page 18, **ADD Crane Rental with Operator to Bid Form**

See attached, updated Bid Form.

Item #5 – Page 18, **ADD B.14 Indemnification**

The successful quoter supplier covenants and agrees to indemnify and save harmless the County, its agents and employees, from and against all claims, suits, actions, damages, causes of action, or judgments arising out of the terms of the resulting contract for any personal injury, loss of life, or damage

to the property sustained as a result of the performance or non-performance of services or delivery of goods; from and against any orders, judgments, or decrees, which may be entered against the County, its agents or employees; and from and against all costs, attorney's fees, expenses and other liabilities incurred in the defense of any such claim, suit or action, and the investigation thereof. Nothing in the award, resulting agreement, contract or Purchase Order shall be deemed to affect the rights, privileges and immunities of the County as set forth in Florida Statute Section 768.28.

Item #6 – Page 19, **MODIFY C.04 Equipment Repair**: The types of equipment that may be repaired as a result of this Invitation to Bid may include **but are not limited to**:

- Other style pumps (Submersible pumps and rewinding covered under another Bid)
- Various types of valves
- Hydraulic systems
- Horizontal Split Cases (HSC) pumps
- Vertical Turbine (VTP) pumps
- Vertical Mix Flow (VMF) pumps
- Positive displacement pumps
- Blowers
- Mixers
- Augers
- Equipment with gearboxes
- Fans

Item #7 – Page 20, **ADD C.06 #6**: “Any parts replaced should not be disposed of until approved by County personnel”.

Item #8 – Page 21, **ADD C.06**, to last paragraph that starts on page 20:


In the event that the County decides that the cost for the repair of any pump be uneconomical to repair, after the tear down and inspection has occurred, the successful Contractor(s) shall return the unrepaired pump to the County location that it was picked up from and shall be allowed to invoice for the time needed to complete the tear down and inspection in accordance with Vaughen’s Motor and Pump Repair Price Guide.

Item #9 – Page 21, **ADD C.07 Field Service Work Defined**:

Field Service Work is defined as, “Extraction and installation of equipment including cold and hot alignment.”

Item #10– **CHANGE Bid Opening Time and Date Due to 3:00 PM on Friday, July 29, 2016.**

All Other terms and conditions of the original Invitation for Bid remain unchanged.
