Dear Mr. White:

In April 2008, Manatee County and Waste Management Inc. of Florida entered into a Solid Waste Franchise Agreement ("Agreement"). In October 2014, Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement was signed, providing for one additional term, not to exceed seven years, commencing on October 1, 2016 and terminating at the end of September 30, 2023. The sixth year of the additional seven-year term will begin on October 1, 2021. Pursuant to Section 3.1.C.2 "Rate Adjustments" of the Agreement, the County has calculated the annual adjustment to Service Fees effective October 1, 2021.

The service fee calculation has been completed using the July 31, 2021 Consumer Price Index (CPI) and the Lower Atlantic PADD 1C No 2 Diesel Ultra Low Sulfur 0-15 ppm Retail Prices Fuel Index. The result of the calculation using the indices as noted, is an increase in the Service Fee schedules (Exhibits B and D of the Franchise Agreement) of 2.66%.

The calculation and data are attached for your reference as well as a spreadsheet with the revised service fees as listed in the Agreement's Exhibits B and D. Should you have any questions or concerns related to either index, or any part of the calculation, please let us know.

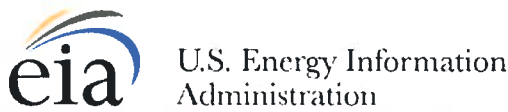

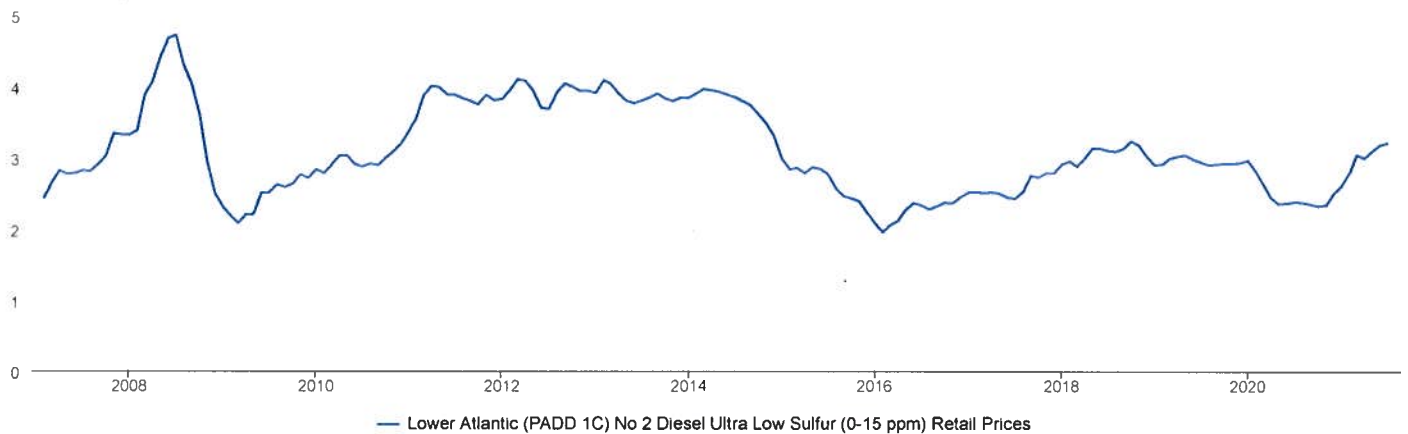

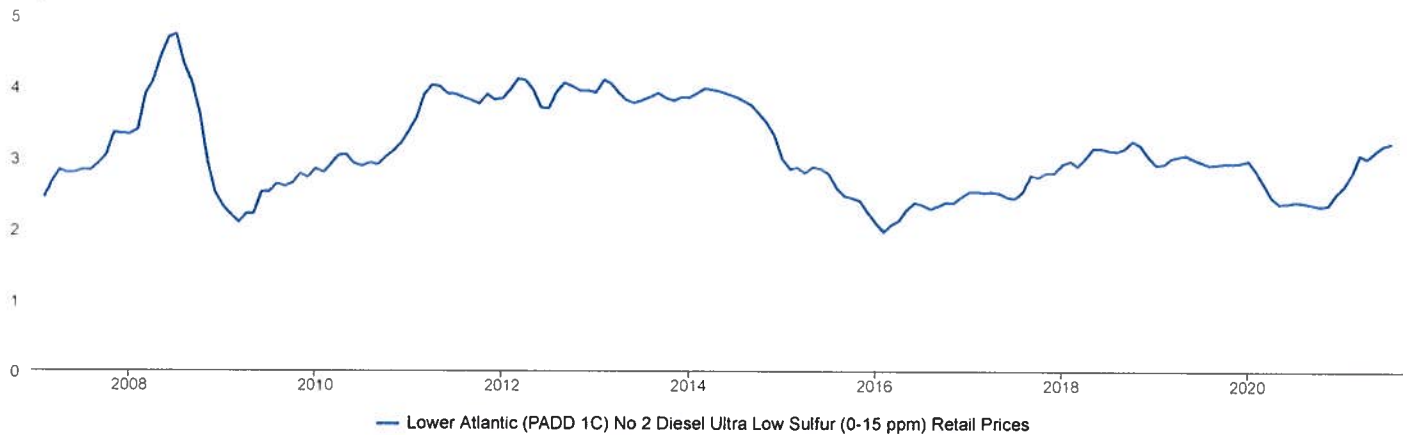
