NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD

The Manatee County Procurement Division provides notice of its intent to award a single source contract to Fracta in the amount of \$149,985.00 for the provision of the Fracta Software as a Service (SaaS) Platform for desktop condition assessments for the County's water main distribution system.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The Manatee County Procurement Division has completed a due diligence review and intends to procure the Fracta Software as a Service (SaaS) Platform from Fracta without conducting a competitive solicitation process for the following reasons:

- The Utilities Department has determined the need for a Software as a Service (SaaS) platform that can complete Likelihood of Failure (LOF), Consequence of Failure (COF), and Business Risk Exposure (BRE) through desktop condition assessments for the County's water main distribution system.
- Through extensive research and testing, the Utilities Department has found that Fracta is the sole company that provides a Software as a Service (SaaS) platform (Fracta Software as a Service (SaaS) Platform) that meets the requirements of the County.
- Fracta is the sole developer, implementor, and distributor of the Fracta Software as a Service (SaaS) Platform; therefore, the goods and services cannot be procured from any other source.
- Procuring the Fracta Software as a Service (SaaS) Platform from Fracta will ensure that the requirements of the Utilities Department are met.

Any company that believes it can provide these goods/services, must submit detailed information about its goods/services to the Manatee County Procurement Division at purchasing@mymanatee.org no later than December 14, 2021 for evaluation and consideration.
