**BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION**

Manatee County Procurement Division has completed a due diligence review and intends to procure scoreboards from NEVCO Sports LLC without conducting a competitive solicitation process for the following reason(s):

- Scoreboards are needed to make the stadium more aesthetically pleasing for the fans, a high-quality scoreboard is an essential part of the sports experience, it is the only thing that unifies fan, coaches, referees, and athletes. The scoreboard controls game clock, score, and ultimately a winner.
- Manatee County is working to upgrade to LED scoreboards at athletic/football fields and use the same style of scoreboard throughout the county to have a standard scoreboard throughout the county.
- Nevco has been found to be the most reliable of the scoreboards purchased. Also, the service they provide has been the easiest to resolving issues with the product.
- Recent replacements have been at Lincoln Park and Palma Sola Park.
