## NOTICE OF INTENT TO NEGOTIATE

The Manatee County Procurement Division provides notice of its intent to negotiate a contract with DRMP, Inc. for the provision of professional transportation engineering services for Erie Road East West Projects - from 69<sup>th</sup> Avenue East to Martha Road and Martha Road to US 301.

## BACKGROUND/EVALUATION

The County requested proposals from qualified firms for the provision of professional transportation engineering design services and other professional services for the Erie Road East West projects. The project will focus on reconstruction of Erie Road in two segments with transitions from 69<sup>th</sup> Avenue East to Martha Road and Martha Road to US 301, including, but not limited to, construction of standard vehicle lane widths, sidewalks, crosswalks, curb, medians, signage and striping, street lighting, piped drainage systems, stormwater ponds, wetland mitigation areas and/or floodplain conservation areas. The Consultant shall furnish all equipment, labor, materials, supplies, licensing, transportation, and other components necessary to provide Professional Transportation Engineering Services and other professional services for the projects.

The solicitation was advertised on the Manatee County website and Bid Sync. It was also provided to the Manatee County Chamber of Commerce and the Manasota Black Chamber of Commerce for release to its members. Responses were received from the following firms:
