BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

Manatee County relies on portable generators to provide power during and after storms that cause power outages. These outages can present dangerous situations due to lack of light and the inability to use water pumps as a backup to the County's reclamation water facilities. The Titan GPS tracking system will enable remote communication and tracking of portable equipment locations and asset data usage. This will provide the County with the documentation required for FEMA disaster recovery, including coordinates and operational hours. The Titan GPS will allow the County to quickly locate areas of concern and respond to power outages and high-water concerns at a much higher rate with remote communication.
