**ACTION REQUESTED**

Request the Purchasing Official authorize cancellation of RFP 17-0177GD Odor and Corrosion Control Services due to a recently completed study by the Engineer of Record consulting firm which will change the technical scope of requirements

**BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION**

Pursuant to Section A.11, "Reserved Rights" of the Request for Proposal, the County is publishing notice of its decision to reject all proposals received in response to the above-mentioned RFP and cancel the RFP.

**PROJECT BACKGROUND:**

The purpose of the Request for Proposal (RFP) was to solicit proposals from qualified individuals, corporations, partnerships and other legal entities to provide Manatee County Utilities Department with comprehensive corrosion and odor control services for its wastewater collections and treatment system. The purpose of the services is to minimize corrosion effects on wastewater infrastructure and to address nuisance odor issues in the system.

At a May 30, 2017 meeting of the Evaluation Committee the Utilities Department Committee representative stated a recent study had been completed by the Engineer of Record consulting firm. The positive results of the study determined the County could obtain better technical results with a potential for saving budgeted funds by taking a different approach to the services. The Committee discussed this and voted unanimously to recommend cancellation of the RFP and rejection of all RFP responses.

Manatee County finds this reason is for good cause and in the best interest of the County.

Utilities Department will be developing new technical requirements for a new RFP solicitation at a future date.
