CHANGE TO:

ADDENDUM NO. 1 DATED MAY 17, 2023, Q15.

Q15. How will the county differentiate low cost if multiple indices are being offered?

- R15. Overall low cost.
- R15. <u>Award(s) will be based on lowest overall fixed markup per gallon and fixed</u> <u>transportation costs</u>. Indices will be vendors choice.

QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES:

Q1. When will bid tabulations be provided after opening?

R1. Submissions and tabulations or summaries are not public record for 30 days or until the notice of intent to award has been published, whichever comes first.

Q2. Are common carriers considered subcontractors?

R2. See Section B, Terms and Conditions, B.26, Subcontractors.

Q3. Is there a conference call or zoom option to listen to bid openings?

R3. No.

Q4. What is the official start date of this contract?

R4. Tentative start date is September 1, 2023.

Q5. Can BOL and invoice examples be provided from previous contract/awardee?

R5. See attached BOL and Invoice.

Q6. What date was referenced for pricing on the previous bid tabulations?

- R6. Dates were not required as part of the bid response.
- Q7. Can "bound original" please be clarified of what they are expecting to be submitted.
- R7. "Bound Original" is a hard copy held together by binder clip, paper clip, or by other means to keep all of the original documents together.

Q8. What are your office hours for bid delivery via FedEx or UPS?

R8. Monday – Friday 7:00 AM – 5:00 PM.

Q9. Are the contract extensions beyond the initial term mutually agreed upon?

- R9. See response to Q10 in Addendum No. 1.
- Q10. The right is reserved for the County to split the award by groups, price, or other such criteria. Do you anticipate splitting the award by product? Do you anticipate splitting the award by Transport & Tank Wagon?
- R10. No.
- Q11. Do we have to bid all options to be considered for an award?
- R11. No.
- Q12. Will a metered bill of lading from the terminal be acceptable in place of the metered truck requirement?
- R12. See response to Q3 in Addendum No. 1.
- Q13. The bid states that you will be reading names and total bid price submitted. As the bid doesn't have a 'total' price line, will you be reading both the Markup and Transportation submitted prices for each line?

- R13. Yes.
- Q14. If we do not attend the bid opening, how and when will we be notified of the low bidder and can we receive a copy of the bid tabulations?
- R14. See response to Q1.
- Q15. The sample Agreement mentions both a Bid Bond of 5% and Performance bond at 100%. Are any bonds required for this bid?
- R15. See response to Q5 in Addendum No. 1.
- Q16. If awarding multiple bidders as in the past, do you anticipate rotating orders between all awarded vendors, or focusing orders from vendors with the lowest combined Markup and Transportation for the particular product & delivery method?
- R16. All vendors are utilized, however, the vendors with lowest markup and greatest reliability receive a larger percentage of orders.

Q17. Will you order split loads to two or more locations?

R17. We generally order full load (1 stop) or split loads (2-3 stops). On occasion we will utilize tank wagons for small quantity, multiple stops to fuel the Park Tanks #'s (101, 102, 42, 43, 50, 51, 52, 54, 55, 56, 99, 103, 104).

Q18. Are we required to bid on the TW portion of this bid?

- R18. See response to Q11.
- Q19. Who are you currently ordering fuel from?
- R19. See response to Q8 in Addendum No. 1.
- Q20. Do you intend on ordering from the lowest bidder, even though multiple vendors will be awarded?
- R20. See response to Q16.
- Q21. How do you determine who each site orders fuel from if multiple vendors are awarded?
- R21. See response to Q16.
- Q22. Will you allow line item charges for pump off fees and multiple site fee separately. These are different charges from common carriers. Pump off is for the pumping into the tank. Multiple site fee is for going to more than one location.

- R22. Yes.
- Q23. It states in the bid that Manatee County is exempt from Federal Excise Taxes and State Sales Tax. Does Manatee County pay any of the following taxes and if so, can you please indicate which ones listed if any are to be included in our bid markup?

State Excise Inspection Fee Ninth Cent Local Option SCETS Pollutants Federal Lust Federal Oil Spill Federal Superfund

R23. The County will pay the following taxes,

- Q24. Can we opt out of the epayables program and be paid by check, ACH or EFT? If not, are we able to pass along credit card processing fees to Manatee County or do we need to factor those fees into our bid markup?
- R24. ePayables is not a requirement, ACH or EFT is still an option.

Q25. Are common carriers considered sub-contractors?

R25. See response to Q2.

Q26. On the bid tabulations from 2017 for the current contract in place, are all 6 awarded vendors utilizing the same index?

- R26. The Intent to Award information can be found at http://www.mymanatee.org > Business > Bids and Proposals > Closed Solicitations and search for 17-1203BLS.
- Q27. In addendum 1 question Q15, if you simply take every supplier's markup and multiply it by the same number of gallons to come up with the total bid amount and then award it to the 6 lowest bidders (or however many you decide) then when do

the chosen indices come into play? Meaning, If I was to bid a markup of .05 over the Tampa OPIS gross unbranded average and another awarded vendor bid a markup of .04 over the Tampa OPIS gross average, how do you determine which pricing formula will be the most advantageous for you? Both of our OPIS prices are going to be different, typically (not always) the unbranded index will be lower.

R27. Award(s) will be based on lowest overall fixed markup per gallon and fixed transportation costs. Indices will be vendors choice.
