BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

Manatee County Procurement Division has completed a due diligence review and intends to procure Monitoring and Reporting Services from GPI to perform annual hydrobiological monitoring and reporting services for four wetlands at the East County Wellfield in Manatee County without conducting a competitive solicitation process for the following reason(s).

GPI consultants wrote the original hydrobiological monitoring plan accepted by Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD) in 2007.

GPI has been performing wetland health monitoring at all four wetland sites since 2009, therefore, they are familiar with the sites and required data collection.

If Manatee County went with another company to perform these services, there would be a lengthy learning curve for the new company having to review data from the past eight years as well as becoming familiar with the hydrobiological monitoring sites.

Manatee County would also loose continuity in the data. The data that is reported to SWFWMD needs to be consistant to maintain our water use permit. Any deviation in data analysis and results would be unacceptable and jeopordize the status of our water use permit.
