- The Work included in this Contract consists of the installation of new 6-inch and 8-inch potable waterlines and new water service connections for the Bayshore on the Lakes Development located in Bradenton, FL. Contractor shall utilize the open-cut construction method in accordance with the Drawings and Specifications. Work also includes grouting of existing 4-inch, 6-inch, and 8-inch waterlines.

The Contractor shall furnish all shop drawings, working drawings, labor, materials, equipment, tools, services and incidentals necessary to complete all work required by these Specifications and as shown on the Contract Drawings.

- 06/24/2011 – 08/01/2011 appropriate bid procedures were followed. Notice of Bid availability was broadcast to nine hundred forty-one (941) suppliers via Onvia DemandStar, [www.mymanatee.org](http://www.mymanatee.org) and the Manatee Chamber of Commerce. Twelve (12) local suppliers were directly solicited for this project. A total of seven (7) bids were received. Two (2) bids each from Hillsborough and Lee Counties, one (1) bid each was received from Miami-Dade, Sarasota and Sumter Counties. Dear Mr. Sowa

Bids for the above referenced project were received on August 1, 2011 from a total of seven (7) contractors. Bid prices ranges from a low of \$1,905,472.15 (submitted by Carl Hankins, Inc.) to a high of \$2,471,870.00 (submitted by Kuxhausen Construction) as shown in the bid tabulation. The following were noted during Carollo's review of the bidding documents received:

- The bid received from Carl Hankins, Inc. contains an error on page 00300-005 of the bid form. The Total Construction Cost: Bid "B" of \$1,942,136.61 does not equal the sum of the Extended Prices. Carollo determined that the correct sum is \$1,905,472.15, which also matches the Total Bid Price "B" shown on page 00300-001. In accordance with Section 00010, A.28 the sum of the Extended Prices was assumed to prevail.

The bidding documents requested two base Bids, "A" and "B" from each bidder. Base Bid "A" is for a completion time of 270 calendar days and Base Bid "B" is for a completion time of 330 calendar days. Carl Hankins, Inc. was the lowest bidder for both Base Bids with an amount of \$1,942,139.61 on Base Bid "A" and \$1,905,472.15 on Base Bid "B".

Carollo used the Florida Department of Business and Professional website to determine the status of the low bidder's license. Carl Hankins, Inc. has been licensed (Certified Underground Utility and Excavation Contractor) since December 6, 2001 and their license is current/active with no complaints on file. Carollo contacted the references from Hillsborough County and the City of Winterhaven and both commented favorably.

Based upon the information provided with each bid and in consideration of the terms and conditions set forth in the contract document, Carollo Engineers recommends that the project be awarded to the low bidder Carl Hankins, Inc. for either Base Bid "A" or Base Bid "B" depending on the County's first preference.

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into by and between the COUNTY OF MANATEE, a political subdivision of the state of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the "COUNTY" and **Carl Hankins, Inc.**, hereinafter referred to as the "CONTRACTOR," duly authorized to transact business in the state of Florida, with offices located at **14512 N. **Article 1. WORK**

CONTRACTOR shall furnish all labor, materials, supplies, and other items required to complete the Work for IFB No. **IFB#11-1897-OV / Bayshore On The Lakes Waterline Replacement Project, Manatee County, FL (Project No. 6072470)** in strict accordance with Contract Documents and any duly authorized subsequent addenda thereto, all of which are made a part hereof.

**Article 2. ENGINEER**

The County of Manatee, Project Management Department, is responsible as the COUNTY and CAROLLO ENGINEERS, INC., hereinafter referred to as "ENGINEER," designed this project and is responsible for technical/engineering reviews and decisions. The ENGINEER is a member of the COUNTY'S project management team which is collectively responsible in ensuring the Work is completed in accordance with the Contract Documents. Where the terms ENGINEER and/or COUNTY are used in the Contract Documents, it shall mean the COUNTY'S project management team.

### **Article 3. CONTRACTOR'S REPRESENTATIONS**

In order to induce COUNTY to enter into this Agreement, CONTRACTOR makes the following representations:

- 3.1 CONTRACTOR has familiarized itself with the nature and extent of the Bid Documents, Work, site, locality and all local conditions and laws and regulations that in any manner may affect cost, progress, performance or furnishing of the Work.
- 3.2 CONTRACTOR has studied carefully all drawings of the physical conditions upon which CONTRACTOR is entitled to rely.
- 3.3 CONTRACTOR has obtained and carefully studied (or assumes responsibility for obtaining and carefully studying) all such examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, reports and studies which pertain to the physical conditions at or contiguous to the site or which otherwise may affect the cost, progress, performance or furnishing of the Work as CONTRACTOR considers necessary for the performance or furnishing of the Work at the Contract Price, within the Contract Time and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bid Documents; and no additional examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, reports, studies or similar information or data are or will be required by CONTRACTOR for such purposes.
- 3.4 CONTRACTOR has reviewed and checked all information and data shown or indicated on the Bid Documents with respect to existing underground facilities at or contiguous to the site and assumes responsibility for the accurate location of said underground facilities. Any additional examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, reports, studies or similar information or data in respect of said underground facilities conducted by the CONTRACTOR will be done at the CONTRACTOR'S expense.

- 3.5 CONTRACTOR has correlated the results of all such observations, examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, reports and studies with the terms and conditions of the Bid.
- 3.6 CONTRACTOR has given COUNTY written notice of all conflicts, errors or discrepancies that have been discovered in the Bid Documents and the written resolution thereof by OWNER is acceptable to CONTRACTOR.
- 3.7 CONTRACTOR shall schedule and perform the Work subject to COUNTY'S approval and shall hold COUNTY harmless from all liabilities incurred due to CONTRACTOR'S failure to coordinate with the COUNTY.

- 5.2 No assignment by a party hereto of any rights under or interest in the Contract Documents will be binding on another party hereto without the written consent of the party sought to be bound; and specifically but without limitation, monies that may become due and monies that are due may not be assigned without such consent (except to the extent that the effect of this restriction may be limited by law); and unless specifically stated to the contrary in any written consent to an assignment, no assignment will release or discharge the assignee from any duty or responsibility under the Contract Documents.
- 5.3 COUNTY and CONTRACTOR each binds itself, its partners, successors, assigns and legal representatives to the other party hereto, its partners, successors, assigns and legal representatives in respect of all covenants, agreements and obligations contained in the Contract Documents.







Such notice shall be served by mailing the same by registered mail or certified mail, postage prepaid, in an envelope addressed to the Principal, Owner or Surety, at any place where an office is regularly maintained for the transaction of business, or served in any manner in which legal process may be served in the state in which the aforesaid project is located, save that such service need not be made by a public officer.
