- 10/11/08 2/6/09 the appropriate proposal procedures were followed. The Request For Proposal (RFP) was advertized locally in the Bradenton Hearld and broadcast via DemandStar to three hundred thirty (330) potential providers of fiber optical cable installation and interconnection fifty one (51) firms downloaded the RFP and eight (8) firms submitted proposals.
- Manatee County firms that were directly contacted and made aware of this Request for Proposal were:
 - 1. IDS
 - 2. Upgrade and Associates
 - 3. Critical Communication Systems
 - 4. Hyatt Survey Services

Although notified, none of these Manatee County firms chose not to respond.

- 2/6/09 the Selection Committee convened and heard oral presentations.
- 2/27/09 the Selection Committee convened and ranked the firms as follows for the purpose of negotiating a contract with the top ranked firm:
 - 1. MasTec North America, Inc., Tampa, FL
 - 2. Henkels & McCoy, Blue Bell, PA
- Ranked #1, MasTec North America, Inc., Tampa, FL The proposer offers a proposal that best
 meets the overall needs of the County. The firm demonstrated to the Selection Committee: its
 experience and familiarity with the County's roadways and thoroughfares (540 miles); detailed
 their current mobilization in the County installing fiber optical cable (they are currently
 performing a similar project for the School Board of Manatee County); installed the
 telecommunication conduit infrastructure that the fiber optical cable will be installed into
 completing the project six months ahead of schedule; and has demonstrated the ability to work
 with the County.
- Ranked #2, Henkels & McCoy, Blue Bell, PA The proposer submitted a satisfactory proposal and demonstrated its experience during the oral presentation it made to the Selection Committee. The firm would use equally experienced subconsultants and/or subcontractors to install the fiber optical cable. However, the firm was ranked second overall due to the Selection Committee's perception of the firm ability to meet the County's requirements in comparison to the selected firm, and lesser experience with the conduit in the County's system.

The remaining respondents not shortlisted are:

Network Cabling Infrastructure, Buford, GA
PCS Inc., Jupiter, FL
TCS Communications, Greenwood Village, CO
The New Florida Industrial
Traffic Control Device Inc., Altamonte Springs, FL

Although well qualified, these firms were not short listed based on a comparison of capability in providing the required services.
