**BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION**

Manatee County Procurement Division has completed a due diligence review and intends to procure Rubonia Nutrient Baffle Boxes from Oldcastle Infrastructure, Inc. without conducting a competitive solicitation process for the following reason(s):

The Rubonia Stormwater Quality Improvement project has reached a crucial phase with the scheduled quarterly cleaning of the stormwater baffle boxes. These essential components, provided by Oldcastle Infrastructure, Inc., play a vital role in removing nutrients and sediment from stormwater. To ensure optimal performance and prevent premature breakdown, it is imperative that these baffle boxes undergo routine maintenance. Due to the specialized nature of the equipment, Oldcastle Infrastructure, Inc. is uniquely positioned to handle the upkeep efficiently and effectively. By entrusting the maintenance to the same company that manufactured and installed the baffle boxes, the project minimizes costs and avoids any potential delays, maintaining the integrity and effectiveness of the stormwater operations in the County.
