Proposals must be delivered to the following location: Manatee County Administration Building, 1112 Manatee Ave. W., Suite 803, Bradenton, FL 34205 prior to the Due Date and Time.

Effective Monday (August 1, 2022), all visitors coming into the Administration Building will need to check in with 311 staff on the first floor by the main entrance to obtain a visitors' badge to access all floors. R2. Resumes should be limited to one (1) page per staff member and do not count against the page limit. Certifications and licenses do not count against the page limit.

Q3. Will there be a standalone contract for Surveying and Mapping portion of the scope of work?
