## **QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES:**

- Q1. Who will be providing the crane?
- R1. The County will let the contractor use its overhead crane.
- Q2. Can you provide the stainless-steel hardware list?
- R2. The contractor shall survey the job and make sure to provide all hardware they need to complete the job.
- Q3. Will the County provide new mechanical seal?
- R3. County will not provide. The mechanical seal will be provided and installed by contractor. The seal must be Chesterton mechanical split seal.
- Q4. If awarded the opportunity, will we be able to take the motor and pump to our shop to epoxy coat and paint the assembly / machine prior to installation?
- R4. Yes, it would be best for the contractor to receive the equipment shipment direct to their shop to do work before installation.
- Q5. Will the County be providing the blue paint that matches the existing piping? if not, what is the color code?
- R5. The County will provide blue paint color code.

- Q6. Do we need to take / deliver the old pump to a particular location once removed?
- R6. No, The County will have a trailer in place to receive the old pump and motor and remove them from the area.
- Q7. Will the old pump and motor be reconditioned / rebuilt?
- R7. No
- Q8. Please clarify the request for providing certification as a pump and motor shop?
- R8. Bidder's license and certification as a pump and motor ship is required to meet the Minimum Qualification Requirements as outlined in IFBC No. 22-R079371JH.
- Q9. Please clarify if any additional manufacturers are able to quote this high service pump?
- R9. The County wants to keep the same Floway Pump manufacturer for replacement.
- Q10. The contract states 14 calendar days to complete. The lead time for the pump assembly and motor is anticipated to be 15-25 weeks. Will time be awarded to the contractor once submittals are provided with lead times?
- R10. The specified 14 calendar days for completion are from the time the contractor starts construction and begins to remove the old pump and motor.
- Q11. The existing pump is Floway brand. Will the County allow for other brands to be considered? If so, please provide approved vertical turbine brands that the County will accept.
- R11. Refer to R9.
- Q12. Can you confirm the pump must be NSF 61 certified as mandated by FDEP?
- R12. NFS61 is required.
- Q13. Does the motor need to be inverter duty rated suitable for VFD usage?
- R13. Yes, inverter duty motor wire / winding required.
- Q14. Is standard 12-month warranty acceptable?
- R14. Please build in 36 months (3 year) warranty.
