BACKGROUND/EVALUATION

The County requested proposals from qualified firms to perform a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study and other Engineering Services to complete a National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) Environmental Impact Statement (EIS). The work includes conducting a PD&E Study to ensure that the Project follows the policies and procedures outlined in NEPA. The successful engineering Consultant (Consultant) will be tasked with collecting data for the study area and conduct alternatives analysis and shall provide the cost of each alternative for design, construction, and future maintenance. The required deliverables for this project include reports, aerials, exhibits and plans necessary to achieve NEPA compliance. Based on the alternative's analysis, an evaluation matrix will be used to eliminate the least desirable alternatives. The PD&E Study shall follow the policies and procedures outlined in the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), to obtain approval from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) for federal grant purposes. The study is not final until the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), after review of the documentation and recommendations, provides project approval. All reasonable alternatives should be considered by the consultant during the PD&E study.
