NOTICE OF INTENT TO NEGOTIATE

The Manatee County Procurement Division provides notice of its intent to negotiate a contract with PCL Construction, Inc. for the provision of Design Build Services for Lake Manatee Water Treatment Plant Alum Sludge Dewatering System.

ENABLING/REGULATING AUTHORITY

Manatee County Procurement Ordinance, Sec 2-26.

BACKGROUND/EVALUATION

The County requested proposals from qualified firms for the provision of Design Build Services for the Lake Manatee Water Treatment Plant Alum Sludge Dewatering System project to include site work, survey, engineering design, and construction services under a single prime contract with a guaranteed maximum price (GMP). The Design Builder will provide all labor, materials, and equipment for the design and construction of a mechanical dewatering system that consists of centrifuges, gravity sludge thickeners, homogenization tanks, a new centrifuge building, pumping and all associated appurtenances necessary for a complete and functional system.

The solicitation was advertised on the Manatee County website and Periscope S2G. It was also provided to the Manatee County Chamber of Commerce and the Manasota Black Chamber of Commerce for release to its members, and in the Bradenton Herald and Tempo News newspapers.
