

Authorization to award IFB #09-0250DC North Regional Water Reclamation Facility Influent Structure, to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, Reynolds, Inc., dba John Reynolds & Sons, Inc., Jacksonville, Florida, in the amount of \$5,215,000 (for Bid "B" - 300 construction days); and for Chairman to subsequently execute contract with simultaneous dating of performance/payment bonds and acceptance of insurance certificates.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This project provides for the construction of a new influent structure (splitter box, headworks) for treatment of raw wastewater at the North County Facility. URS Corporation, a professional consultant to the County, designed this project and will assist in contract administration during construction. • 11/19/08 to 02/26/09 appropriate bid procedures were followed. Bids were solicited via DemandStar to one thousand eight hundred sixty-two (1,862) prospective bidders and suppliers and notice of its availability was posted on the County's website. One hundred and sixty-two (162) firms requested the Bid Document, of which fifty-eight (58) firms were local. Thirteen (13) bids were received; three bids were from local firms. • Estimated start of construction is 05/11/09 with completion within 300 days for an estimated completion date of 03/07/10. • The funding sources for this project are Sewer Facility Investment Fees and Utilities 2003 and 2006 Bond Funds.
