

#### DRAINAGE NARRATIVE

#### **FOR**

### US 301 @ ELLENTON GILLETTE RD. INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

Manatee County wishes to modify the existing intersection of US 301 with Ellenton Gillette Rd. as follows:

- 1) Modify the south bound approach on Ellenton Gillette Rd. to add a 2<sup>nd</sup> left turn lane and a dedicated right turn lane,
- 2) Modify the east bound approach by closing the median opening on Manatee Avenue, thereby allowing the left turn lane to be extended,
- 3) Installing a new mast arm traffic signal.


These improvements will enhance the overall safety and functionality of this intersection.


The existing drainage system on US 301 consists of a series of storm boxes beginning just east of Ellenton Gillette Rd. and extending westward for approximately 1,200 LF. The roadway drainage discharges into a creek draining south towards to Manatee River at this point. Copies of the limited Drainage Plan information available for this area are attached.

No significant impacts to the existing drainage system are anticipated with this construction as:

- 1) The only revision to the existing draining system will be the relocation of the existing inlet at the NE corner of the intersection. This relocation will allow for a better turning radius in this location.
- 2) Work on US 301 is limited to paving a small median cut at Manatee Avenue. All other work is milling and resurfacing.
- 3) The existing drainage patterns on Ellenton Gillette Rd. will be maintained. The existing storm drain system north of US 301 along the east side of the road will remain in place.

The minor pavement addition south of US 301 will continue to drain away from US 301.





### FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION STORMWATER POLLUTION PREVENTION



#### The Law

The Federal Clean Water Act was established in 1972 to protect our waterways. As a result, the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) program was developed. The NPDES permit program addresses water pollution by regulating point sources that discharge pollutants to surface waters. The Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) administers the NPDES program for Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4) and Construction activities.

#### **CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES**

> Is your construction site regulated?

Yes, if your construction activity will ultimately disturb one acre or more and has the potential to discharge stormwater to surface waters or into a MS4. Disturbance includes clearing, grading, excavation, and demolition.

- What are you required to do?
  - ✓ Prepare and implement a Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP)
  - ✓ Submit a Notice of Intent (NOI or application) and the appropriate fee to FDEP
  - ✓ Submit a Notice of Termination (NOT) to FDEP and to the local MS4 once the site meets the eligibility requirements for termination



a. Speed limit is 45 mph or less.

b. No sight obstructions to vehicles approaching the work area for a distance equal to twice the taper length.

d. The closed lane is occupied by a class 5 or larger, medium duty truckfs with a minimum gross weight vehicle rating (GWVR) of 16,001 lb with high-intensity, rotating, flashing, oscillating, or strobe lights mounted above the cab height and operating.

2. For work operations up to 60 minutes, the arrow board may be omitted if conditions a, b, and c in DURATION NOTE I are met, and vehicles in the work area have high-intensity, rotating, flashing, oscillating, or strobe lights operating.

DURATION NOTES

1. For work operations up to approximately 15 minutes, signs, channelizing devices, and arrow board may be omitted if all of the following conditions are met:

- If the work area is confined to an auxiliary lane the work area shall be barricaded and the RIGHT (LETT) LANE CLOSED AHEAD signs replaced by ROAD WORK AHEAD signs, and the merge symbol signs eliminated.
- When vehicles in a parking zone block the line of sight to TCZ signs, the signs shall be post mounted and located in accordance with Index No. 17302.
   If the work space extends across a crosswalk, the crosswalk should be closed using the information in Index No. 660.
   Signs are required on the median side for divided highways.
- 4. Signs are required on the median side for divided highways.
  5. The two channelizing devices directly in front and directly at the end of the work area may be omitted provided vehicles in the work area have high-intensity rotating. flashing, or strobe lights operating.






