## **BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION**

The Manatee County Procurement Division has completed a due diligence review and intends to procure VESTA Citizen Input and Smart Transcription Services from Motorola Solutions, Inc. without conducting a competitive solicitation process for the following reasons:
