SECTION 00010 INFORMATION TO BIDDERS

A.01 OPENING LOCATION

These bids will be <u>publicly opened</u> in the Manatee County Purchasing Office, 1112 Manatee Avenue West, Suite 803, Bradenton, Florida 34205 in the presence of County officials at the time and date stated. All bidders or their representatives are invited to be present.

A.02 BID INFORMATION AND BID DOCUMENTS

A.03 BID FORM DELIVERY REQUIREMENTS

Any bids received after the stated time and date will not be considered. It shall be the sole responsibility of the bidder to have their bid <u>delivered to the Manatee County Purchasing Office</u> for receipt on or before the stated time and date. If a bid is sent by <u>U.S. Mail</u>, the bidder shall be responsible for its timely delivery to the Purchasing Office. Bids delayed by mail shall not be considered, shall not be opened at the public opening, and arrangements shall be made for their return at the bidder's request and expense. Telegraphic bids and/or facsimile bids will not be considered.

A.04 CLARIFICATION & ADDENDA

Each bidder shall examine all Invitation For Bids documents and shall judge all matters relating to the adequacy and accuracy of Any inquiries, suggestions or requests such documents. concerning interpretation, clarification or additional information pertaining to the Invitation For Bids shall be made through the Manatee County Purchasing Office. The County shall not be responsible for oral interpretations given by any County employee, representative, or others. The issuance of a written addendum is the only official method whereby interpretation, clarification or additional information can be given. If any addenda are issued to this Invitation for Bids, the County will attempt to notify all prospective bidders who have secured same, however, it shall be the responsibility of each bidder, prior to submitting their bid, to contact the Manatee County Purchasing Office (see contact on page 1) to determine if addenda were issued and to make such addenda a part of their bid.

A.05 SEALED & MARKED

A.06 LEGAL NAME

Bids shall clearly indicate the <u>legal name</u>, <u>address</u> and <u>telephone</u> <u>number</u> of the bidder. Bids shall be <u>signed</u> above the <u>typed or printed name</u> and <u>title</u> of the signer. The signer must have the authority to bind the bidder to the submitted bid.

A.07 BID EXPENSES

All expenses for making bids to the County are to be borne by the bidder.

A.08 IRREVOCABLE OFFER

Any bid may be withdrawn up until the date and time set for opening of the bid. Any bid not so withdrawn shall, upon opening, constitute an <u>irrevocable offer for a period of 90 days</u> to sell to Manatee County the goods or services set forth in the attached specifications until one or more of the bids have been duly accepted by the County.

A.09 RESERVED RIGHTS

The County reserves the right to accept or reject any and/or all bids, to waive irregularities and technicalities, and to request resubmission. Also, the County reserves the right to accept all or any part of the bid and to increase or decrease quantities to meet additional or reduced requirements of the County. Any sole response received by the first submission date may or may not be rejected by the County depending on available competition and current needs of the County. For each item or for all items combined, the bid of the lowest responsive, responsible bidder will be accepted, unless all bids are rejected. The lowest responsible bidder will be accepted, unless all bids are rejected. The lowest bid to sell goods and/or services of a quality which conforms closest to or most exceeds the quality of goods and/or services set forth in the attached specifications or otherwise required by the County, and who is fit and capable to perform the bid as made.

To be <u>responsive</u>, a bidder shall submit a bid which conforms in all material respects to the requirements set forth this Invitation For Bids.

A.09 RESERVED RIGHTS (Continued)

To be a <u>responsible</u> bidder, the bidder shall have the capability in all respects to perform fully the contract requirements, and the tenacity, perseverance, experience, integrity, reliability, capacity, facilities, equipment, and credit which will assure good faith performance. Also, the County reserves the right to make such investigation as it deems necessary to determine the ability of any bidder to deliver the goods or service requested. Information the County deems necessary to make this determination shall be provided by the bidder. Such information may include, but shall not be limited to: current financial statements, verification of availability of equipment and personnel, and past performance records.

Upon receipt, all inquiries and responses to inquires related to this Invitation For Bid or Request For Proposal become "Public Records" and are subject to public disclosure consistent with Chapter 119, Florida Statutes.

Bids or Proposals become "Public Records" ten (10) days after the proposal opening or if an award decision is made earlier than this time as provided by Florida Statue 119.071. No announcement or review of the bid or proposal documents shall be conducted at the public opening of the proposals.

A.10 APPLICABLE LAWS

Bidder or Proposer must be authorized to transact business in the State of Florida. All applicable laws and regulations of the <u>State of Florida</u> and ordinances and regulations of Manatee County will apply to any resulting agreement. Any involvement with any Manatee County procurement shall be in accordance with <u>Manatee County Purchasing Code Ordinance 08-43</u>, as amended. Any actual or prospective Bidder or Proposer who is aggrieved in connection with the solicitation or award of a contract may protect to the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County as required in <u>Section 2-26/61 of the Purchasing Code</u>.

A protest with respect to this Invitation For Bid or Request for Proposal shall be <u>submitted in writing prior to the scheduled opening date of this proposal</u>, unless the aggrieved person did not know and could not have been reasonably expected to have knowledge of the facts giving rise to such protest prior to the scheduled opening date of this proposal. The protest shall be submitted <u>within seven calendar days</u> after such aggrieved person knows or could have reasonably been expected to know of the facts giving rise thereto.

A.11 CODE OF ETHICS

With respect to this proposal, if any Bidder or Proposer violates or is a party to a violation of the <u>Code of Ethics</u> of Manatee County per Manatee County Purchasing Code Ordinance 08-43, Article 3, Ethics in Public Contracting, and/or the state of Florida Statutes, Chapter 112, Part III, code of Ethics for Public Officers and Employees, such Bidder or Proposer many be disqualified from performing the work described in this proposal or from furnishing the goods or services for which the proposal is submitted and shall be further disqualified from submitting any future bids or proposals for work or for goods or services for Manatee County.

The County anticipates that all statements made and materials submitted in a Proposal will be truthful. If a bidder or proposer is determined to be untruthful in its proposal or any related presentation, such bidder or proposer many be disqualified from further consideration regarding this Invitation For Bid or Request For Proposal.

A.12 COLLUSION

By offering a submission to this Invitation for Bids, the bidder certifies that the bidder has not divulged, discussed or compared their bid with other bidders, and <u>has not colluded</u> with any other bidder or parties to this bid whatsoever. Also, bidder certifies, and in the case of a joint bid each party thereto certifies as to their own organization, that in connection with this bid:

- a. any prices and/or cost data submitted have been arrived at independently, without consultation, communication, or agreement, for the purpose of restricting competition, as to any matter relating to such prices and/or cost data, with any other bidder or with any competitor;
- any prices and/or cost data quoted for this bid have not been knowingly disclosed by the bidder and will not knowingly be disclosed by the bidder, prior to the scheduled opening, directly or indirectly to any other bidder or to any competitor;
- c. no attempt has been made or will be made by the bidder to induce any other person or firm to submit or not to submit a bid for the purpose of restricting competition;

A.12 COLLUSION (Continued)

- d. the only person or persons interested in this bid, principal or principals is/are named therein and that no person other than therein mentioned has any interest in this bid or in the contract to be entered into; and
- e. .no person or agency has been employed or retained to solicit or secure this contract upon an agreement or understanding or a commission, percentage, brokerage, or contingent fee accepting bona fide employees or established commercial agencies maintained by bidder for purpose of doing business.

A.13 BID FORMS

Bids must be submitted on attached County forms, although additional pages may be attached. Bidders must fully comply with all bid specifications, terms and conditions. Failure to comply shall result in contract default, whereupon, the defaulting vendor shall be required to pay for any and all re-procurement costs, damages, and attorney fees as incurred by the County.

A.14 DISCOUNTS

Any and all discounts must be incorporated in the prices contained in the bid; and not shown separately. The prices as shown on the bid form shall be the price used in determining award(s).

A.15 TAXES

Manatee County is exempt from Federal Excise and State Sales Taxes. (F.E.T. Exempt Cert. No. 59-78-0089K; FL Sales Tax Exempt Cert. No. 51-02-027548-53C); therefore, the vendor is prohibited from delineating a separate line item in his bid for any sales or service taxes. Nothing herein shall affect the vendor's normal tax liability.

A.16 MATHEMATICAL ERRORS

In the event of multiplication/extension error(s), the unit price shall prevail. In the event of addition error(s) the extension totals will prevail. All bids shall be reviewed mathematically and corrected, if necessary, using these standards, prior to additional evaluation. Calculations shall be factored to the second decimal point.

A.17 DESCRIPTIVE INFORMATION

Unless otherwise specifically provided in the specifications, all equipment, materials and articles incorporated in the work covered by this contract shall be new and of the most suitable grade for the purpose intended. Unless otherwise specifically provided in the Contract Documents, reference to any equipment, material, article or patented process, by trade name, brand name, make or catalog number, shall be regarded as establishing a standard of quality and shall not be construed as limiting competition.

A.18 MODIFICATION OF BID SPECIFICATIONS

If a bidder wishes to recommend changes to the bid specifications, the bidder shall furnish in writing, data and information necessary to aid the County in evaluating the request to modify the bid Contract Documents.

The County is not obligated to make any changes to the bid Contract Documents. Unless an addendum is issued as outlined in paragraph A.04, six calendar days prior to the opening date of this bid, the bid Contract Documents shall remain unaltered. Bidders must fully comply with the bid Contract Specifications, terms, and conditions.

A.19 AMERICAN DISABILITIES ACT

The Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, does not discriminate upon the basis of any individual's disability status. This non-discrimination policy involves every aspect of the County's functions including one's access to, participation, employment, or treatment in its programs or activities. Anyone requiring reasonable accommodation for an **Information Conference** or **Bid Opening** should contact the person named on the first page of this Bid document at least twenty four (24) hours in advance of either activity.

A.20 LOBBYING

After the issuance of any Invitation for Bids or Request for Proposals, prospective bidders, proposers or any agent, representative or person acting at the request of such bidder or proposer shall not contact, communicate with or discuss any matter relating in any way to the Invitation For Bids or Request For Proposals with any officer, agent or employee of Manatee County other than the Purchasing Director or as directed in the Invitation For Bids or Request For Proposals. This prohibition begins with the issuance of any Invitation For Bids, or Request For Proposals, and ends upon execution of the final contract or when the invitation or request has been canceled. Violators of this prohibition shall be subject to sanctions as provided in the Manatee County Purchasing code.

The County reserves the right to amend or to add to the names listed as persons to contact. All amendments or additions to the names listed as persons to contact shall be issued by the Purchasing Office, in writing.

A.21 DRUG FREE WORK PLACE

The Manatee County Board of County Commissioners adopted a policy regarding Bidders maintaining a Drug Free Work Place, prohibiting the award of bids to any person or entity that has not submitted written certification to the County that it has complied with those requirements

[Reference Resolution R 08-43, Manatee County Purchasing Policies, Section 4, E (1) (a)].

A Drug Free Work Place Certification Form is attached to this bid for this purpose.

A.22 PUBLIC CONTRACTING AND ENVIRONMENTAL CRIMES CERTIFICATION

In accordance with Section 287.133, Florida Statutes, a person or affiliate who has been placed on the convicted vendor list following a conviction for a public entity crime may not submit a bid on a contract to provide any goods or services to a public entity, may not submit a bid on a contract with a public entity for the construction or repair of a public building or public work, may not submit bids on leases or real property to a public entity, may not be awarded or perform work as a contractor, supplier, subcontractor, or consultant under a contract with any public entity, and may not transact business with any public entity in excess of the threshold amount provided in Section 287.017 for Category Two (as of 1/01/2005 is \$25,000) for a period of 36 months from the date of being placed on the convicted vendor list.

A.23 PUBLIC CONTRACTING AND ENVIRONMENTAL CRIMES CERTIFICATION

In accordance with Ordinance 08-43, adding Article 5, Manatee County Board of County Commissioners adopted a policy prohibiting the award of County contracts to persons, business entities, or affiliates of business entities who have not submitted written certification to the County that they have not been convicted of bribery, attempted bribery, collusion, restraints of trade, price fixing, and violations of certain environmental laws. A Non-Conviction Certification Form is attached for this purpose.

A.24 EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY CLAUSE

Manatee County, in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Regulations of the Department of Commerce (15 CFR, Part 8) issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all vendors that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this advertisement and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color or national origin in consideration for an award.

A.25 DISCLOSURE

Upon receipt, all inquires and responses to inquires related to this Invitation For Bid or Request For Proposal become "Public Records" and are subject to public disclosure consistent with Chapter 119. Florida Statutes.

A.26 MBE/WBE

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

B.01 CONTRACT FORMS

Any agreement, contract, or Purchase Order resulting from the acceptance of a bid shall be made by a purchase order and be bound by the terms and conditions herein.

B.02 SUBCONTRACTORS

Subcontractors shall be bound by the terms and conditions of this contract insofar as it applies to their Work, but this shall not relieve the prime contractor from the full responsibility to the Owner for the proper completion of all Work to be executed under this contract.

The employment of unauthorized aliens by any vendor is considered a violation of Section 274(e) of the Immigration and Employment Act. If the vendor knowingly employs unauthorized aliens, such violation shall be cause for unilateral cancellation of this agreement.

B.03 AUTHORIZED PRODUCT REPRESENTATION

The vendor, by virtue of submitting the name and specifications of a manufacturer's product, will be required to furnish the named manufacturer's product. The vendor's failure to perform accordingly may, in the County's sole discretion, be deemed a breach of contract, and shall constitute grounds for the County's immediate termination of the contract.

B.04 QUALITY GUARANTEE

If any product/service delivered does not meet performance representations or other quality assurance representations as published by manufacturers, producers or distributors of such products or the specifications listed in this bid, the vendor shall pick up the product from the County at no expense to the County. The County reserves the right to reject any or all materials if, in its judgment, the item reflects unsatisfactory workmanship or manufacturing or shipping damage. Also, the vendor shall refund to Manatee County any money which has been paid for same. The vendor will be responsible for attorney fees in the event the supplier defaults and court action is required.

B.05 ROYALTIES AND PATENTS

The vendor shall pay all royalties and license fees for equipment or processes in conjunction with the equipment and/or services he is furnishing. Vendor shall defend all suits or claims for infringement of any patent, trademark or copyright, and shall save the County harmless from loss on account thereof, including costs and attorney's fees.

B.06 INDEMNIFICATION

The contractor covenants and agrees to indemnify and save harmless the County, its agents and employees, from and against all claims, suits, actions, damages, causes of action, or judgments arising out of the terms of the resulting agreement for any personal injury, loss of life, or damage to the property sustained as a result of the performance or non-performance of services or delivery of goods; from and against any orders, judgments, or decrees, which may be entered against the County, its agents or employees; and from and against all costs, attorney's fees, expenses and other liabilities incurred in the defense of any such claim, suit or action, and the investigation thereof. Nothing in the award, resulting agreement, contract or Purchase Order shall be deemed to affect the rights, privileges and immunities of the County as set forth in Florida Statute Section 768.28.

B.07 REGULATIONS

It shall be the responsibility of the bidder to assure compliance with any OSHA, EPA and/or other Federal or State of Florida rules, regulations or other requirements, as each may apply.

B.08 MANUALS, SCHEMATICS, HANDBOOKS

All manuals, schematics and handbooks shall be provided which are applicable to the equipment delivered. An operators manual, parts manual and technician manual must also be provided. Parts lists (manuals) must include OEM part numbers for items not manufactured by the bidder. Vendor shall furnish two (2) copies of each publication.

SPECIFIC TERMS & CONDITIONS

C.01 PURPOSE

It is the intent of the County of Manatee to purchase on an as required basis, <u>SMALL SCALE ROOF REPAIRS AND INSTALLATION SERVICES</u>, which may consist of installation of new roofing and a range of roof repairs, at various job sites within Manatee County. It is the specific purpose of this bid to establish an annual contract for the required materials and services and to secure the cost and availability of the materials for procurement.

C.02 BLANKET ORDER

Blanket Purchase Order(s) shall be issued as a result of this bid. A Blanket Purchase Order number, when accompanied by a valid Release Order number provided by an authorized County department, will authorize purchases on an "as required" basis. (Note: The quantities shown on the Bid Form are estimates only. There is no guarantee that these quantities will be released).

A master agreement with subsequent individual orders shall be used, therefore for payment; each invoice must indicate the Blanket Purchase Order number followed by a valid Release Order number. The vendor is not authorized to proceed with, and will not be compensated for, any work that is not authorized by a valid Release Order Number issued by the County's Representative.

Quantities of purchases will vary depending on the authorized budget of each authorized County department. Bid items, package size, and unit prices shall be as itemized on the attachment to the Blanket Purchase Order. Make no shipments until a valid release order is provided.

C.03 QUANTITIES

Exact quantities of service to be procured under this contract cannot be determined at this time. Orders will be issued on an "as required basis"; this may include all or part of the quantities specified, or may result in additional quantities. The quantities listed are estimated and only given as a guideline for preparing your quote and should not be construed as representing actual quantities to be purchased.

C.04 WORK AUTHORIZATION

Any work authorized for procurement under this contract shall be on an "as required" basis at various locations within the County. The vendor is not authorized to proceed with, and will not be compensated for, any work that is not authorized by a valid Release Order Number issued by the County's Representative. All work shall be scheduled with the County's Representative.

The vendor shall be given a scope of work for each project and shall be required to visit the work site. The vendor's quote to the County for completing the work shall include the number of days to complete the work and the total price to complete the work, including the work items required in accordance with the attached Quote Form. The County reserves the right to disapprove the quote and shall have no obligation to issue a Release Order for the work.

If during performance of the Work, additional work is determined to be required, a written proposal must be provided to the County for approval before any additional work is performed.

C.05 DELIVERY

The primary goal of this contract is the speedy acquisition of repair services; vendor's responsiveness under the terms of this contract is paramount. Upon notification (verbal or written) of a need for services, the vendor shall acknowledge the request and shall be expected to prepare a quote for presentation to the County Representative and at a minimum provide temporary repairs within 24 hours from time of notification; emergency situation response time shall be within **four (4) hours**. The repair work shall be completed within seven (7) calendar days after County's acceptance of the quote (unless otherwise approved by the County). Failure to respond within the time specified may result in the work being performed by others and/or termination of this contract.

C.06 PRICES & TERM

Bidders shall bid unit prices, F.O.B. Destination, including all discounts in accordance with unit of quantity indicated on Bid Form. The prices bid shall be used for payment and shall be deemed to include payment in full for all transportation, labor, and equipment used in delivering all supplies and materials to the point of delivery.

C.07 LIMITATIONS- \$100,000 PER PROJECT

This contract is for small scale roof repairs and installation, and as such no single project exceeding \$100,000.00 shall be done under this contract. Instead a separate bidding process, including performance and payment bonds, shall occur for those projects that exceed this amount.

If your quotation for any single project would be in an amount of \$100,000.00 or more, please do not submit your quote or reveal you're pricing, but return the quote form stating that your quotation would exceed this amount.

C.08 RENEWAL

If not cancelled by the Vendor or the County, **this contract shall be automatically extended/renewed** beyond the first 12 month contract period for additional 12 month periods not to exceed total contract duration of 36 months providing there are no changes of prices, terms or conditions.

Written notice of intention not to renew must be submitted by the successful bidder 90 days prior to the end of a contract period.

Should any Vendor choose not to renew the bid awarded, the County reserves the right to terminate the Contract with that Vendor and select the next qualified bidder, or re-advertise for those bid items, or solicit a new Invitation for Bid for all items (including multiple bid awards).

C.09 PRICE ADJUSTMENTS FOR RENEWAL PERIODS

Prices shall remain firm for the first twelve month base contract term. Requested price changes for the remaining terms may be adjusted in accordance with the <u>Producers Price Index for Asphalt Shingle and Coatings Mfg, Primary Services Code 324122P</u>. The base index shall be the index effective on the date of Award. The index used for each successive renewal period shall be the effective index on the date of renewal.

The maximum acceptable increase for any renewal term shall be the percentage calculated in accordance with the method described in the Producers Price Index from the Bureau of Labor Statistics.

C.10 PAYMENT

Within forty-five (45) days after delivery by the vendor, acceptance by the County, and presentation of an appropriate invoice, the County shall pay the total amount due. Payment invoices must indicate both the Blanket Purchase Order number and the Release Order number.

C.11 CANCELLATION

It is mutually understood and agreed that any award made as a result of this bid may be canceled by the vendor upon 90 days written notice by Certified Mail to the County. However, the County is hereby authorized to purchase, in accordance with the prices bid, any quantity of materials and/or services during this 90 day interim provided the County requests delivery during this period.

The County reserves the right to terminate a contract by giving 30 days written notice of intention to terminate if at any time the vendor fails to abide by or fulfill any of the terms and conditions of the contract. The County also reserves the right to terminate this contract for the convenience of the County, with or without cause.

C.12 WARRANTY, MAINTENANCE SERVICE AND SUPPORT

All work, materials, and equipment furnished as defined herein shall be guaranteed and warranted by the contractor for a minimum period of one (1) year, unless otherwise specified, from final acceptance by the Owner to be free from defects due either to faulty materials or equipment or faulty workmanship. The Owner shall, following discovery thereof, promptly give written notice to the contractor of faulty materials, equipment, or workmanship within the period of the guarantee and the contractor shall promptly replace any part of the faulty equipment, material, or workmanship at his own cost. Roof Maintenance is to be done in accordance with the most current Manufacturers' specifications.

C.13 INSURANCE

The vendor will not commence work under a contract until the vendor has obtained <u>all insurance</u> under this section and such insurance coverage as might be required by the County. The vendor shall obtain, at his expense, the following minimum amounts of insurance (inclusive of any amounts provided by an umbrella or excess policy):

a. Workers' Compensation/Employers' Liability

<u>Part One</u> - There shall be no maximum limit (other than as limited by the applicable statute) for liability imposed by Florida Worker's Compensation Act or any other coverage required by the contract documents which are customarily insured under Part One of the standard Worker's Compensation Policy.

<u>Part Two</u> - The minimum amount of coverage for the coverage required by the contract documents which are customarily insured under Part Two of the standard Workers' Compensation Policy shall be:

The limits afforded by the OCP Policy and any excess policies shall apply only to the Owner and the Owner's officials, officers, agents and employees and only to claims arising out of or in connection with the work under this contract.

e. Certificates of Insurance and Copies of Policies

Certificates of Insurance in triplicate evidencing the insurance coverage specified in the above paragraphs shall be filed with the Purchasing Director before operations are begun. Insurance shall remain in force at least one year after completion and acceptance of the project by the County, in the amounts and types as stated herein, including coverage for all products and services completed under this contract.

f. <u>Property Insurance</u>

If this contract includes construction of or additions to above ground buildings or structures, contractor shall provide "Builder's Risk" insurance with the minimum amount of insurance to be 100% of the value of such addition(s).

g. <u>Installation Floater</u>

If this contract does not include construction of or additions to above ground building or structures but does involve the installation of machinery or equipment, contractor shall provide an "Installation Floater" with the minimum amount of insurance to be 100% of the value of such addition(s), buildings(s), or structure(s).

ADDITIONAL INSURED: The contractor shall name Manatee County as additional insured in each of the applicable policies.

Nothing herein shall in any manner create any liability of the County in connection with any claim against the vendor for labor, services, or materials, or of subcontractors; and nothing herein shall limit the liability of the vendor or his sureties to the County or to any workers, suppliers, materialmen or employees.

If the initial insurance expires prior to the completion of operations and/or services by the vendor, renewal certificates of insurance and required copies of policies shall be furnished by the vendor and delivered to the Purchasing Director thirty (30) days prior to the date of their expiration.

C.14 AUTHORIZED PRODUCT REPRESENTATION

The contractor, by virtue of submitting the name and specifications of a Manufacturer's product, will be required to furnish the named manufacturer's product. Failure to perform accordingly many, in the County's sole discretion, be deemed a breach of contract, and shall constitute grounds for the County's immediate Termination of the contract.

C.15 MATERIAL/SAFETY DATA SHEET

It shall be the responsibility of the awarded bidder(s) to submit, upon notification of award, a Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) for all toxic substances in accordance with Florida Statues Chapter 442, The Right To Know Law, which mandates on-site MSDS for all toxic substances appearing in the work place.

C.16 PROJECT SCHEDULE

As Release Orders are issued under the Blanket Purchase Order for roof repair services, individual project schedules will need to be supplied by the vendor and approved by the County, for each project.

C.17 CONSTRUCTION OF CONTRACT

This Contract and the rights and responsibilities hereunder shall not be construed more strongly against either party, regardless of the extent to which such party may have participated in the preparation hereof.

SPECIFICATIONS

D.01 SCOPE

The Work shall consist of the installation of new roofing and a range of roof repairs. The Vendor shall provide all labor, material, equipment and supervision necessary for the installation of new roofing and roof repairs as specified by Manatee County Property Management Department. The work specified herein will be performed on public property, based on work orders issued by the County. The work specified in this Invitation for Bid is not meant to cover every roof repair and is not limited to just those items listed.

The work **excludes** any work or repair that is covered under existing roof system warranties supplied by manufacturers or contractors. It is the intent of these specifications to identify all materials, labor, and equipment required to complete the Work.

This annual contract shall include all costs to furnish all required labor, materials, equipment and supervision to perform small scale roof repairs, on an as required basis, for (but not limited to):

- 1) Built-up (asphalt/tar and gravel) and modified bitumen systems and associated flashings;
- 2) Metal roofing systems;
- 3) Single-ply membranes
 - a). Thermoplastic membranes (e.g., PVC, TPO)
 - b). Thermoset membranes (e.g., EPDM)
- 4) Three tab and dimensional type shingles of both fiberglass and asphalt composition and associated flashing.

The work resulting from this contract may involve various scenarios, i.e., one story or two or more story buildings, a 10-square feet repair task or a 100-square feet, etc. It is the County's intent to secure a vendor to repair roofs on a small scale or to repair a roof in order to contain the damage until procurement can be accomplished for the major repair/replacement. The height range on most existing County buildings is 20 to 30 feet. The tallest County building is the Administration Building, which stands approximately 150 feet tall.

D.02 EXECUTION OF WORK

The vendor shall provide temporary repairs within twenty-four (24) hours (four (4) hours for emergencies) of notification by the County of damage to an existing roof to restore a watertight condition. All necessary repair/replacement work shall be completed no later than seven (7) calendar days (unless otherwise approved by the County) after notification by the owner of a roof leak, tear, or other failure of any portion of the roofing system. All work shall be performed in strict accordance with all sections of manufacturer's specifications for materials. No roofing shall be removed that cannot be replaced to a watertight condition in one day's working time or prior to the onset of inclement weather. The vendor shall exercise extreme care to prevent water intrusion into the building interior during demolition removal and replacement.

The vendor shall be responsible for all cutting and patching necessary, inside and outside the building. Exterior cutting may include, but is not limited to, existing roof covering, substrate, flashing, soffit and fascia surfaces as necessary to properly complete the Work. Patching shall match adjacent surfaces and finishes.

D.03 GENERAL ROOFING REQUIREMENTS

- A. The vendor shall obtain all permits, licenses, and certificates or any such approvals of plans or specifications as may be required by federal, state and local laws, ordinances, rules and regulations, for the proper execution and completion of the work specified herein.
- B. Before starting work the Vendor shall furnish a copy of the approved city or county permit to the Manatee County Property Management Department.
- C. Upon installation of new roof, all flashings shall be replaced; including chimneys, valleys, eaves drips, and any other critical areas. All roof penetrations shall be flashed with metal step flashing or metal counter flashing.
- D. All vents and stacks projecting through roof shall have approved flashing.
- E. All roofing shall be installed in accordance with the applicable roofing code. For reference guide to installing asphalt roofing shingles, see Publication #3-RR09152F Owens Corning quality roofing shingles.

D.03 GENERAL ROOFING REQUIREMENTS (Continued)

- F. All roofing shall be flashed per applicable code with drip trim all around, backed by new 1"x4", at a minimum, pressure treated wood strip.
- G. All damaged or rotted sheathing or decking boards shall be replaced with new.
- H. No new roofs will be installed over any old roofing. Sheathing supporting verge rafters shall extend back onto the roof at least 4'.
- I. Install roofing in one continuous operation.
- J. Seven (7) galvanized nails are required for each shingle and shall be installed according to the applicable roofing code. When new roofing is installed in conjunction with aluminum fascia, eaves drips, gravel stops, and flashing shall be matching aluminum.
- K. All joints and flashing shall be bonded with plastic roofing cement and made weather tight. Seal all edges.
- L. Drop sheet to be used for property protection at all roof loading points for the built up roofs. The vendor shall use drop sheet from the roof edge to ground to cover all hard surfaces. The drop sheet shall remain until completion of work.
- M. The vendor shall take all necessary precautions to protect the contents of the buildings from exposure to weather and construction.
- N. Unless otherwise specified, all materials shall be new and match existing material, style, and color.
- O. All roof repairs shall be warranted by the contractor against leaks for a minimum period of one (1) year. Contractor shall submit manufacturer's standard product warranty upon completion of repair (if applicable).
- P. New installations of asphalt and fiberglass shingle roof systems shall be warranted by the contractor against leaks for a minimum period of three (3) years and new installations of all other roof systems shall be warranted by the contractor against leaks for a minimum period of ten (10) years. All installations of new roof systems shall be warranted by the manufacturer for a minimum period of twenty (20) years.

The County of Manatee, Property Management Department, is responsible as the OWNER and ENGINEER of this project. The ENGINEER is responsible for technical/engineering reviews and decisions.

The ENGINEER is also responsible in ensuring the Work is completed in accordance with the Contract Documents.

B. 2 to 12 to 4 to 12 rise:

Perform work as specified above, with two layers of 30 pound felt paper.

C. The color of all new shingles shall be as indicated in the work order regardless of existing color. (Note: All materials shall be new and match existing material, style, and color.)

D.05 APPLICATIONS (Continued)

2. **Built-up Roofing**

Remove existing roofing material, existing lumber, drip edge, and flashing down to wood decking. Install new drip edge of pressure treated lumber, to match existing removed, along the entire perimeter of the roof. Install new flashings and 26 gauge galvanized painted metal gravel stop. Apply four ply hot mopped built-up roofing with flood coat and gravel. Example:

Dry in with Type 43 glass base sheet or compatible, hot mop three fiberglass felts, flood coat with hot asphalt and embedded gravel according to manufacturers' instructions and as specified herein.

3. Single Ply Torch Applied Roofing

Remove existing roofing material and flashing down to existing decking. Install new 26 gauge galvanized painted metal flashing and apply single ply granulated surfaced modified roofing membrane by either torch or hot asphalt over Type 43 glass base sheet or compatible according to manufacturers instructions and general requirements specified in General Roofing Requirements.

4. Single Ply Thermal Plastic Roofing

Remove existing roofing and flashing down to existing decking. Repair damaged or secure loose decking. Remove loose debris and dust. For mechanically fastened systems, the edge of the first sheet is secured with approved fasteners at specified intervals with the edge of the next sheet overlapping the row of fasteners and welded to the previous sheet using manufacturer's specifications. For fully adhered systems, over properly prepared substrate, position sheet and fold over to allow access to roof. Apply continuous coat of bonding adhesive to the exposed bottom side of the membrane and a mirrored area of the substrate in amounts according to manufacturer's specifications. After sufficient drying time, maneuver glued portion of membrane over glued substrate surface, avoiding bubbles and wrinkles by using a roller to ensure contact. Repeat process for the remaining portion of the sheet, overlapping the next sheet. Heat weld all edges

5. <u>5V-Crimp, Standing Seam, Snap-on Seam and Corrugated</u> Metal Roofing

Begin installation at the end of roof, opposite the prevailing wind. Place all panels properly side and end-lapped with proper fastening and maximum water seal. Provide a drip edge with 3 inches of overhang, 1" where gutters are used. Complete installation at gable, ridge and the entire roof according to manufacturer's instructions.

6. Roof Sheathing

Plywood sheathing shall be standard C-D grade, DFPA. Standard Grade, ½"x4'x8', 5/8"x4'x8' or ¾"x4"x8"minimum, with clips between each rafter. Allowable spans shall be as stated in the local and state building codes. Strip sheathing shall be a 1"x4" minimum. All end joints shall be made over a rafter. Sheathing supporting verge rafters shall extend back onto roof a minimum of 4'.

D.06 PERMITS /FEES/ REGUALTIONS

Vendor shall be required to give all necessary notices, obtain all permits and inspections, and pay all costs in connection with the Work. Vendor shall assure compliance with any OSHA, EPA, and/or federal, state, and local rules, regulations. Any conflicts between the specifications and code shall be brought to the attention of the County's representative and resolved before the Work is continue.

D.07 PROJECT CLOSE-OUT

At the close-out of all projects, the vendor shall:

- 1. Clean Work area and remove any and all excess materials and debris. Correct any damages to property that may have occurred as a result of your Work.
- 2. The Vendor shall remedy any deficiencies / incomplete items promptly
- 3. The Vendor shall provide a written report of what repairs were made, list materials used and man hours required to complete the repairs.

D.08 USE OF PREMISES/SITE ACCESS

- The County shall occupy and use the premises and portions of the building not affected by the roof installation. The Vendor shall take all precautions necessary to protect the building and its occupants during the installation period and shall minimize interruptions and inconvenience to the daily operations of the facilities. Any required removal of County personnel shall be the responsibility of the County.
- Vendor shall confine operations at the site to the areas directed by the County's representative. Portions of the site beyond areas on which work is indicated are not to be disturbed. Conform to site rules and regulations affecting the Work.

- 3. Keep existing driveways and entrances serving the premises clear and available to the County at all times. Do not use these areas for parking or storage of materials. Lock vehicles when parked and unattended, so as to prevent unauthorized use. Do not leave such vehicles unattended with the motor running or ignition key in place.
- 4. Vendor shall maintain the existing building in a safe and clean condition throughout the installation period--local and/or state safety codes shall be strictly observed. Repair damage caused by the installation operations. Take all precautions necessary to protect the building(s) and its occupants during the performance of the work. Keep public areas free from accumulation of waste materials, rubbish, or debris. Smoking or open fires will not be permitted within the building enclosure or on the premises. It is Vendor's responsibility to dispose of all waste generated in the course of the Work.
- 5. Vendor's personnel shall not pass into areas beyond the designated "limits of work". The Vendor shall be responsible for supplying equipment for personnel access to the roof; and shall provide toilet facilities for his personnel.
- 6. Vendor shall be responsible for raising his equipment and materials to the roof.

D.09 REGULATIONS / MATERIAL DISPOSAL

The Vendor shall be responsible for disposal of all old and new roofing materials generated in the performance of the Work. The Vendor shall apply for, acquire, post, and achieve inspections' compliance for all applicable permits required by federal, state, or local rules, regulations, or law.

D.10 ASBESTOS REMOVAL

The County will evaluate the area (s) of concern. If abatement is required, it will be completed by a certified abatement contractor.

BASIS OF AWARD

E.01 BASIS OF AWARD

Awards will be made to the lowest, responsive and responsible multiple bidders. It is the intent of the County to place orders with the lowest priced responsive, responsible bidders who can provide the material or service at the time needed for the length of time required. The County reserves the right to place orders with other vendors, in the event of an urgent, immediate need, and/or delivery time and availability of service requested cannot be met by the lowest priced vendor at the time of need.

Whenever two or more bids which are equal with respect to price, quality and service are received, a bid received from a local business shall be given preference in award. Whenever two or more bids which are equal with respect to price, quality and service are received, and both bids or neither of these bids are received from a local business, the award shall be determined by a chance drawing conducted by the purchasing office and open to the public.

Local business is defined as a business duly licensed and authorized to engage in the sale of goods and/or services to be procured, which has a place of business in Manatee County with full time employees at that location.

E.02 QUALIFICATIONS OF BIDDERS

Each bidder must secure all licenses required (in accordance with Chapter 489 Florida Statutes) for the Work which is the subject of this bid; and, upon request, shall submit a true copy of all applicable licenses. Bidder shall be a Florida Certified Roofing Contractor and have performed verifiable work on roof repairs and replacements as specified herein. Contractor must have been in business as a roofing contractor for at least five continuous years. Evidence shall be submitted showing the vendor is an authorized applicator of the system furnished.

To demonstrate qualifications to perform the Work, each bidder must be prepared to submit within five days of County's request; written evidence such as financial data, previous experience, present commitments and other such data as may be requested. Bidder must be able to provide evidence of Bidder's qualification to do business in the state of Florida. Each bidder shall submit as a portion of their bid a completed Contractor's Questionnaire included as Attachment "A".
