BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

- The County IT Department currently manages the County communication towers at various sites around the County and has available space on these towers to lease space to others (for the expansion of their communication services) without interference with County operations. The sites available for leasing are communication towers on: the Northwest and Buffalo Creek water towers, monopoles at Myakka, Duette, and Lorraine Road, the Public Safety Center, and a self-supporting tower located on County Road 675 in East County.
- The RFP was advertised on the Manatee County website, DemandStar, in the Bradenton Herald and the Tempo News and was also provided to the Manatee County Chamber of Commerce for release to its members. Two proposals were received:
 - o AT&T Mobility Corporation, Lake Mary, FL
 - o Verizon Wireless, Boca Raton FL

- The Evaluation Committee Members consisted of:
 - o Wilfred Miranda, Radio Communications Manager, Information Technology
 - o Ernie McFarland, Technical Systems Support Coordinator, Public Safety
 - o Deborah Carey-Reed, Contracts Negotiator, Purchasing
- The Evaluation Committee convened on August 19, 2013 and based on the proposals submitted, discussed the qualifications of each of the proposers, appraised their past work experience, and reviewed their proposal against the RFP criteria. The Committee unanimously voted that oral interviews would not be required; the proposals included sufficient information to evaluate the qualifications and the proposed configuration for equipment installation and radio frequencies.
- Spire Development, Inc. (Agent for AT&T Mobility Corporation)
 Spire Development Inc. is an agent for AT&T Mobility Corporation and has presented a thorough proposal with design schematics of the proposed equipment and tower connections. Spire will also construct a storage building for housing of proposer's radio cabinets and spare equipment.

Verizon Wireless

Verizon Wireless also provided a thorough proposal with a schematic design for the equipment configuration and will construct a storage unit for their equipment.
