The Manatee County Procurement Division provides notice of its intent to award a contract with Westra Construction Corp. for the provision of Pond Control Measures at IMG.

### BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The Scope of Work is for pond control measures at IMG. The Work includes the construction and installation of two (2) pond level monitoring structures with monitoring equipment, and installation of actuated gate valve and the associated reclaimed water assembly. The Contractor will furnish all shop drawings, work drawings, labor, materials, equipment, tools, services and incidentals necessary to complete all Work required by the specifications.

The solicitation was advertised on May 9, 2018 on the Manatee County website and DemandStar. It was also advertised in the Bradenton Herald and The Tempo news and was provided to the Manatee County Chamber of Commerce and the Manasota Black Chamber of Commerce for release to its members.
